# **Clean And Unclean In Scripture**

There are many references in Scripture to the clean and the unclean, and to the pure and the impure. But most people don't understand the significance of these terms in regard to the teachings of Scripture. They're lost in the fog of "washing-vs-not washing", etc.

However, there is indeed great significance attached to these terms. They do not, in most cases, refer to physical cleanliness. They refer most often to moral cleanliness - or the lack thereof. And they range from the concept of being "pure" to that of being "filthy". There are multiple variations related to the nuances of a particular concept, but at the heart of all this are some very foundational concepts.

When understood from this perspective the terms take on a different connotation. Clean (in all its various forms) actually refers to a state of "**undefilement**". Unclean (in all its various forms) actually refers to a state of "**defilement**".

Scripturally defilement, or, in its absence, undefilement, has to do with one's status in relationship to YAHWEH, The Elohim (God) of Scripture.

If one is **defiled** they're seen as "**contaminated**" - typically the result of following the ways of the world. If they are **undefiled**, however, they are seen as "**uncontaminated**" - typically the result of following the ways of YAHWEH.

We need to remember that no one with a significant defect was allowed into YAHWEH's presence (The Tabernacle or The Temple - His "dwelling place"). A defect was also viewed as a defilement. With It one was not "pure", i.e., "uncontaminated".

This included one who was "damaged" (broken bones, etc.)

as well as one that was "defective" from birth. With this in mind, every defilement is a "defect". Sin (rebellion against YAHWEH) was seen as a defilement. YAHWEH does not tolerate sin in His presence.

The consequences of one's defilement, or their undefilement, have to do with one's privilege to enter into the very presence of YAHWEH Himself.

If you are **undefiled** - and thus following His ways - you are **granted access** to Him. If you are **deflied** - and thus following the ways of the world - you are **not granted access** to Him. It's really just that simple. It's profoundly important to understand what's at stake (symbolicaly, but also quite literally, it's the torture stake of YAHUSHUA, The Messiah).

Tradition, however,

has greatly confused the heart of the matter. Tradition is what human beings have passed on to other human beings. It's the "practice" of doing things the way our predecessors have done them. And tradition has given us multiple "words" that are used to convey "cleanliness", or "uncleanliness"; hence, defilement or undefilement.

The result, at the very least, is a bewildering lack of clarity concerning what Scripture really intends. At worst, it deceives us into thinking "cleanliness" is merely a "physical" matter, and therefore has little to do with our mental and moral attitudes, beliefs, and actions.

Yet everything in Scripture is connected to "cleanliness" - to being uncontaminated, unsoiled and **undefiled** before YAHWEH. Without this lack of defilement your relationship with YAHWEH is far less than He desires. In fact, without it you **cannot** have a relationship with Him at all.

This presents a real problem for us. If we can't have a relationship with Him because we are defiled why even bother to try to be or to become undefiled? It seems like an impossible task.

This is precisely where Scrpture, YAHWEH's Word to us, comes to our rescue. (Read that as "our salvation", or "our redemption".) YAHWEH has provided the means by which we, through no real effort on our own, can become undefiled.

Once we are seen by Him as undefiled we can receive the gift (privilege, not a "right") of being able to enter into His presence.

Indeed, <u>THIS</u> is the entire point and focus of Scripture! Without a relationship with YAHWEH there is NO rescue, there is NO deliverance, there is NO "salvation"!

Scripture provides the details: - on how we can become undefiled! Scripture provides the reasons - why we should become undefiled! Scripture provides the teachings - on how to be seen by YAHWEH as undefiled!

But - you will never understand this Truth unless you commit your entire life to YAHWEH and dedicate yourself to seeking His ways <u>above everything else</u> in your life - so you can live according to His desires.

Given below are many references to "clean" and "unclean". Also provided are the Hebrew and Greek terms used to help us understand the meaning of these concepts (not just the words).

The profusion of different terms at first looks somewhat overwhelming. But once you comprehend the basic concepts of undefiled and defiled you'll have little trouble grasping the real meanings involved. And you'll begin to comprehend that **everything in Scripture** is connected to these concepts. There are a number of Hebrew terms that have no equivalent in Greek. A comparison of the Hebrew text and the Greek Septuagint (a very old Greek "translation" of the text) quickly reveals the places where this affects what is translated.

The Greek terms used attempt to convey the Hebrew concepts, but because they're less than accurate in portraying accurately the Hebrew concepts they leave us with a serious lack of comprehension of what the original terms intended to convey. This is particularly true where there is no equivalent term in the Greek language.

This quickly reveals the significant difficulty of trying to transfer Hebrew understandings into the Greek language. Where this becomes vitally important is in The New Covenant. The Hebraic meaning is often completely lost in the "translation" - first into Greek, and then into English - which further compounds the problem.

Perhaps the only way to truly "get it right" would be to become an expert in Hebrew, Greek, and English. Yet even then some concepts would be missed. This is due in part to the movement from ancient Hebrew to contemporary Hebrew, and the shift in the meanings of certain terms that is known to have taken place.

Some individual Greek terms are used to "translate" several Hebrew ones, the Hebrew terms being combined under one Greek concept. This is often very misleading and confusing. One term represents several others. It is not properly "translating" the terms.

The one thing that becomes pretty clear, however, is that **clean means undefiled** and **unclean means defiled**.

Remember, the main focus is one's relationship with YAHWEH.

Are you undefiled, or defiled? If you are undefiled you are permitted access to Him. If you are defiled you are excluded from Him - and even from "The Camp" (the congregation).

Most of the defilement/undefilement has to do with one's moral state. By violating, or rejecting YAHWEH's instructions (commands, rules, teachings, etc.) one becomes "contaminated" - defiled. By faithfully following His desires one lives within a state of being undefiled.

Hence, cleanness or uncleanness is typically determined by the manner in which you respond to YAHWEH's words. If you place Him first and foremost in your life you tend to remain "uncontaminated" - undefiled: - clean, pure, etc.

If you place Him in **any other position** you tend to remain "contaminated" - defiled: - unclean, impure, filthy, corrupt, etc.

Some Hebrew terms are bewildering to the western mind. It's difficult for us to comprehend how the Hebrews arrived at the interpretation they held of certain terms. Even to modern day Jews there are a number of terms that are "of uncertain meaning". We can only guess at what they may mean by looking at the context in which they appear - and even then we may well miss the full intent.

Fortunately, many of these are not critical to our faith or belief in YAHWEH. They don't change our essential perceptions of Him or of His desires for us. They only affect our understanding of the precise meaning of the terms in question.

The primary goal of this study, and others like it that are being prepared, is to help eliminate confusion within The Scriptures. The current state of affairs has left us with innumerable "translations" that are not really "translations" at all. Instead, they are misleading presentations of the "traditions of men".

There's a special term for this. It's called **eisegesis.** It means placing one's own ideas into a text to make it conform to one's own world view or belief system. **Exegesis**, on the other hand, is seeking to discover what the text actually says, and means.

In this word study the following conventions will be used: **term** = proper or best translation {} = Writer's insertions for purposes of clarity. **[not used]** = the term is not translated in the KJV as the key word for this study. The primary definitions are from Strong's Exhaustive Concordance. Everything after the (--) is a word that's used in the KJV to "translate" the Hebrew or Greek term into English. You'll see a number of rather confusing "translations" as you review these. Just remember, these are **not** part of the definition itself. W: = Wilson's Old Testament Words meanings. [G-] = Greek equivalent terms (some of them are not included)

Note: The list of Greek terms precedes The New Covenant Section

# HEBREW TERMS:

If you look closely at the words you'll note various connections between them. Many are simply the same term with different vowel pointings - and thereby have been given "different meanings".

Keep in mind that in the original Hebrew there were **no vowel pointings**. Thus, these are really the same word. But our present understanding of them has been impacted by these vowel pointings.

Also take note of the **root words** involved. They are important guides to fundamental meanings.

Now you have a sense of the bewildering number of Hebrew terms "translated" as clean/pure, or unclean/impure. The terms that occur infrequently have less impact, but they are still important to our understanding of the concepts of "undefiled" and "defiled".

It's obvious that there are different types of "cleansing" - for which there are some very specific terms to help make the distinction. It's also evident that the English words used to "translate" the text of the KJV Bible often cause much confusion because of the inconsistencies in the way things are "translated".

What's given below seeks to provide more consistency and clarity in the terms. This is part of an effort to prepare a new version of The Old Covenant text with language that is more easily understood. While some revisions have been made there is much yet to be done.

Please recognize that almost every reference to clean and unclean, to pure and impure, to holy and profane, etc. **all could well be translated as undefiled or defiled,** and you would still correctly understand the fundamental meaning of the text.

### H444 - morally corrupt - [Defiled]

Job 15:16 How much more detestable and **morally corrupt** *is* man, who drinks iniquity like water?

Psa. 14:3 They have all gone aside, they are *all* together become **morally corrupt**: *there is* none that does good, no, not one.

Psa. 53:3 Every one of them has gone back: they have altogether become **morally corrupt**; *there is* none that does good, no, not one.

### H1249 - pure - [Undefiled]

Job 11:4 For you have said, My doctrine *is* pure, and I am **pure** in your eyes.

Psa. 19:8 The statutes of YAHWEH *are* right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of YAHWEH *is* **pure**, enlightening the eyes.

Psa. 24:4 He that has **innocent (H5355)** hands, and a **pure** heart; who has not lifted up his being to vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.

Psa. 73:1 Truly The Elohim is good to Israel, even to such as are of a pure heart.

Prov. 14:4 Where no oxen *are*, the crib *is* **pure**: but much increase *is* by the strength of the ox.

Song 6:9 My dove, my complete (perfect?) one; she *is* the *only* one of her mother, she *is* the **pure** *one* of her that bare her. The daughters saw her, and blessed her; *yes*, the queens and the concubines, even they praised her.

Song 6:10 Who *is* she *that* looks forth as the morning, fair as the moon, **pure** as the sun, *and* terrible as *an army* with banners?

### H1252 - purity - [Undefiled]

2Sam. 22:21 YAHWEH rewarded me according to my right actions: according to the **purity** of my hands has He repaid me.

2Sam. 22:25 Therefore YAHWEH has repaid me according to my right actions; according to my **purity** in His sight.

Job 22:30 He shall not deliver the **innocent (H5355)**: and he is delivered by the **purity** of your hands.

Psa. 18:20 YAHWEH rewarded me according to my right actions; according to the **purity** of my hands has He repaid me.

Psa. 18:24 Therefore YAHWEH has repaid me according to my right actions, according to the **purity** of my hands in his sight.

### H1305 - to clarify, cleanse - [Undefiled] {to separate that which is impure}

2Sam. 22:27 With the **cleansed** You will show Yourself **cleansed**; and with the distorted You will show Yourself twisted.

1Chr. 7:40 All these *were* the children of Asher, heads of *their* father's house, **clean** mighty men of valour, chief of the princes. And the number throughout the genealogy of them that were apt to the war *and* to battle *was* twenty and six thousand men.

1Chr. 9:22 All these *which were* **cleansed** to be porters in the gates *were* two hundred and twelve. These were reckoned by their genealogy in their villages, whom David and Samuel the seer did ordain in their set office.

1Chr. 16:41 And with them Heman and Jeduthun, and the rest that were **cleansed**, who were expressed by name, to give thanks to YAHWEH, because his kindness *endures* for ever;

Neh. 5:18 Now *that* which was prepared *for me* daily *was* one ox *and* six **cleansed** sheep; also fowls were prepared for me, and once in ten days store of all sorts of wine: yet for all this required not I the bread of the governor, because the bondage was heavy upon this people.

Job 33:3 My words *shall be from* the correctness of my heart: and my lips shall utter **clarified (cleansed)** knowledge.

Psa. 18:26 With the **cleansed** You will show Yourelf **cleansed**; and with the distorted You will show Yourself twisted.

Eccl. 3:18 I said in my heart concerning the estate of the sons of men, that The Elohim might **clarify (cleanse)** them, and that they might see that they themselves are beasts.

Is. 49:2 And He has made my mouth like a sharp sword; in the shadow of His hand has He hidden me, and made me a **cleansed** shaft; in His quiver has He hidden me;

Is. 52:11 Depart, depart, go out from there. Touch no **defiled thing (2931)**; go out of the midst of her; be **cleansed**, you who bear the vessels of YAHWEH.

Zeph. 3:9 For then will I turn to the people a **cleansed** language, that they may all call upon the name of YAHWEH, to serve him with one consent.

Lev. 12:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If a woman has conceived seed, and born a man child: then she shall be **defiled (2930)** seven days; according to the days of **rejection (5079)** for her **sickness** shall she be **defiled (2930)**.

{menstrual flow was considered "sickness"]

### H1739 - sick - [Defiled]

Lev. 15:33 And of her that is **sick** by means of her **defilement (5079)**, and of him that has a seminal discharge, of the man, and of the woman, and of him that lies with her that is **defiled (2931)**.

Lev. 20:18 And if a man shall lie with a woman having her **sickness**, and shall uncover her nakedness; he has discovered her fountain, and she hath uncovered the fountain of her blood: and both of them shall be cut off from among their people.

Is. 30:22 You shall **defile (2930)** also the covering of your engraved images of silver, and the ornament of your molten images of gold: you shall cast them away like a **sick** (**menstruous**) covering; you shall say to it, Get out!.

Lam. 1:13 From above has He sent fire into my bones, and it prevails against them: He hath spread a net for my feet, He has turned me back: he has made me desolate *and* **sick** all the day.

Lam. 5:17 For this our heart is **sick**; for these *things* our eyes are dim.

### H2134 - clear - without impurities - [Undefiled]

Ex. 27:20 And you shall command the children of Israel, that they bring you oil **without impurities**, olive, beaten for the light, to cause the lamp to burn always. Ex. 30:34 And YAHWEH said unto Moses, Take to yourself sweet spices, stacte, and onycha, and galbanum; *these* sweet spices with frankincense **without impurities**: of each shall there be a like *weight*:

Lev. 24:2 Command the children of Israel, that they bring to you oil **without impurities**, olive, beaten for the light, to cause the lamps to burn continually.

Lev. 24:7 And you shall put frankincense **without impurities** upon *each* row, that it may be on the bread for a memorial, *even* an offering made by fire to YAHWEH.

Job 8:6 If you were **without impurities** and upright; surely now He would awake for you, and make the habitation of your right actions prosperous.

Job 11:4 For you have said, My doctrine *is* **without impurities**, and I am **pure (1249)** in your eyes.

Job 16:17 Not for *any* injustice in mine hands: also my prayer *is* **without impurities**.

Job 33:9 I am **without impurities** without violation, I *am* innocent; neither *is there* iniquity in me.

Prov. 16:2 All the ways of a man *are* **without impurities** in his own eyes; but YAHWEH weigheth the vital essences.

Prov. 20:11 Even a child is known by his doings, whether his work *is* **without impurities**, and whether *it is* right.

Prov. 21:8 The way of man *is* very perverse and carries guilt: but *as for* the one **without impurities**, his work *is* right.

### H2135 - to be innocent - [Undefiled]

Job 15:14 What *is* man, that he should be **innocent**? and *he which is* born of a woman, that he should be just?

Job 25:4 How then can man be just with The Elohim? or how can he be **innocent** *that is* born of a woman?

Psa. 51:4 Against You, You only, have I sinned, and done *this* evil in Your sight: that You might be just when You speak, *and* be **innocent** when You pronounce sentence.

Psa. 73:13 Verily I have **cleansed** my heart *in* vain, and washed my hands in **innocency (5356)**.

Psa. 119:9 BETH. How shall a young man **cleanse** his way? By taking heed according to Your word.

Prov. 20:9 Who can say, I have made my heart **innocent**, I am **purified (2891)** from my sin?

Is. 1:16 Wash yourself. Make youself **innocent**. Put away the destruction of your doings from before My eyes; cease to do damage;

Mic. 6:11 Shall I count *them* **innocent** with the wicked balances, and with the bag of deceitful weights?

### H2141 - clean - [Undefiled]

Job 9:30 If I wash myself with snow water, and make my hands never so clean;

Job 15:15 Behold, he puts trust in His set apart ones; indeed, the heavens are not **clean** in His sight.

Job 25:5 Behold even to the moon, and it shines not; indeed the stars are not **clean** in His sight.

Lam. 4:7 Her Nazarites were **cleaner** than snow, they were whiter than milk, they were more ruddy in body than rubies, their polishing *was* of sapphire:

### H2212 - refine, purge - [Undefiled]

1Chr. 28:18 And for the altar of incense **refined** gold by weight; and gold for the pattern of the chariot of the cherubims, that spread out *their wings*, and covered the Ark of the Covenant of YAHWEH.

1Chr. 29:4 *Even* three thousand talents of gold, of the gold of Ophir, and seven thousand talents of **refined** silver, to overlay the walls of the houses:

Job 28:1 Surely there is a vein for the silver, and a place for gold where they refine it.

Job 36:27 For He makes small the drops of water: they **refine** rain according to the vapor thereof:

Psa. 12:6 The words of YAHWEH *are* **pure** (2889) words: *as* silver **refined with fire** (6884) in a furnace of earth, **refined** seven times.

Is. 25:6 And in this mountain shall YAHWEH of Assemblies make to all people a feast of fat things, a feast of wines on the lees, of fat things full of marrow, of wines on the lees well **refined**.

Mal. 3:3 And he shall sit *as* a **refiner by fire (6884)** and **purifier (2891)** of silver: and he shall **purify (2891)** the sons of Levi, and **refine** them as gold and silver, that they may offer to YAHWEH an offering in right actions.

### H2889 - pure - [Undefile]

**Note:** Virtually every place this term is used it refers to something that is undefiled, uncontaminated.

Gen. 7:2 You shall take with you seven each of every **pure** animal, a male and his female; two each of animals that *are* **not pure**, a male and his female;

Gen. 7:8 Of **pure** animals, of animals that *are* **not pure** of birds, and of everything that creeps on the earth,

Gen. 8:20 Then Noah built an altar to YAHWEH, and took of every **pure** animal and of every **pure** bird, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.

> Note: One must ask, "How did Noah know what was "pure" and what was "impure"? Nothing in the text provides a clue concerning this knowledge. And this was pre-flood knowledge.

Ex. 25:11 And you shall overlay it with **pure** gold, inside and out you shall overlay it, and shall make on it a molding of gold all around.

Ex. 25:17 "You shall make a mercy seat of **pure** gold; two and a half cubits *shall be* its length and a cubit and a half its width.

Ex. 25:24 And you shall overlay it with **pure** gold, and make a molding of gold all around.

Ex. 25:29 You shall make its dishes, its pans, its pitchers, and its bowls for pouring. You shall make them of **pure** gold.

Ex. 25:31 "You shall also make a lampstand of **pure** gold; the lampstand shall be of hammered work. Its shaft, its branches, its bowls, its *ornamental* knobs, and flowers shall be *of one piece*.

Ex. 25:36 Their knobs and their branches *shall be of one piece;* all of it *shall be* one hammered piece of **pure** gold.

Ex. 25:38 And its wick-trimmers and their trays shall be of pure gold.

Ex. 25:39 It shall be made of a talent of **pure** gold, with all these utensils.

Ex. 27:20 "And you shall command the children of Israel that they bring you **clear (2134)** oil of pressed olives for the light, to cause the lamp to burn continually.

Ex. 28:14 and you shall make two chains of **pure** gold like braided cords, and fasten the braided chains to the settings.

Ex. 28:22 "You shall make chains for the breastplate at the end, like braided cords of **pure** gold.

Ex. 28:36 "You shall also make a plate of **pure** gold and engrave on it, *like* the engraving of a signet: SET APART TO YAHWEH.

Ex. 29:36 And you shall offer a bull every day *as* a sin offering for atonement. You shall [*cleanse - 2398 - to miss; to sin - in the piel form, to cleanse or purify*)] **have made amends for** the altar by making atonement upon it, and you shall anoint it to sanctify (consecrate) it.

This is a difficult concept for the Western mind to grasp. The sin offering was made to obtain atonement for one's sin. That act brought with it the state of being undefiled. The altar was defiled. It, as well as the person who sinned, needed to become undefiled. The sin offering acted as that which "made amends" for the defilement that was on the altar, thereby "purifying" (undefiling) it. Althought two different Hebrew terms are used (one of them twice) each one essentially brings about atonement (making amends with YAHWEH - satisfying His requirements for becoming undefiled.).

Ex. 30:3 And you shall overlay its top, its sides all around, and its horns with **pure** gold; and you shall make for it a molding of gold all around.

Ex. 30:34 And YAHWEH said to Moses: "Take sweet spices, stacte and onycha and galbanum, and **pure** frankincense with *these* sweet spices; there shall be equal amounts of each.

Ex. 30:35 You shall make of these an incense, a compound according to the art of the perfumer, salted, **pure**, *and* holy.

Ex. 31:8 the table and its utensils, the **pure** *gold* lampstand with all its utensils, the altar of incense,

Ex. 37:2 He overlaid it with **pure** gold inside and outside, and made a molding of gold all around it.

Ex. 37:6 He also made the mercy seat of **pure** gold; two and a half cubits *was* its length and a cubit and a half its width.

Ex. 37:11 And he overlaid it with **pure** gold, and made a molding of gold all around it.

Ex. 37:16 He made of **pure** gold the utensils which were on the table: its dishes, its cups, its bowls, and its pitchers for pouring.

Ex. 37:17 He also made the lampstand of **pure** gold; of hammered work he made the lampstand. Its shaft, its branches, its bowls, its *ornamental* knobs, and its flowers were of the same piece.

Ex. 37:22 Their knobs and their branches were of one piece; all of it *was* one hammered piece of **pure** gold.

Ex. 37:23 And he made its seven lamps, its wick-trimmers, and its trays of **pure** gold. Ex. 37:24 Of a talent of **pure** gold he made it, with all its utensils.

Ex. 37:26 And he overlaid it with **pure** gold: its top, its sides all around, and its horns. He also made for it a molding of gold all around it.

Ex. 37:29 He also made the holy anointing oil and the **pure** incense of sweet spices, according to the work of the perfumer.

Ex. 39:15 And they made chains for the breastplate at the ends, like braided cords of **pure** gold.

Ex. 39:25 And they made bells of **pure** gold, and put the bells between the pomegranates on the hem of the robe all around between the pomegranates:

Ex. 39:30 Then they made the plate of the holy crown of **pure** gold, and wrote on it an inscription *like* the engraving of a signet: SET APART TO YAHWEH.

Ex. 39:37 the **pure** *gold* lampstand with its lamps (the lamps set in order), all its utensils, and the oil for light;

Lev. 4:12 Even the whole bullock shall he carry forth outside the camp to a **pure** place, where the ashes are poured out, and burn him on the wood with fire: where the ashes are poured out shall he be burned.

Lev. 6:11 And he shall put off his garments, and put on other garments, and carry forth the ashes outside the camp to a **pure** place.

Lev. 7:19 And the flesh that touches any **defiled (2931)** *thing* shall not be eaten; it shall be burned with fire: and as for the flesh, all that are **pure** shall eat thereof.

Lev. 10:10 And that you may put difference between holy and unholy, and between **defiled (2931)** and **pure**;

Lev. 10:14 And the wave breast and heave shoulder you shall eat in a **pure** place; you, and your sons, and your daughters with you: for *they are* your due, and your sons' due, *which* are given out of the sacrifices of peace offerings of the children of Israel.

Lev. 11:36 Nevertheless a fountain or pit, *wherein there is* plenty of water, shall be **pure**: but that which touches their carcase shall be **defiled (2931)**. Lev. 11:37 And if *any part* of their carcase falls upon any sowing seed which is to be sown, it *shall be* **pure**.

Lev. 11:47 To make a difference between the **defiled (2931)** and the **pure**, and between the beast that may be eaten and the beast that may not be eaten.

Lev. 13:13 Then the priest shall consider: and, behold, *if* the leprosy has covered all his flesh, he shall pronounce *him* clean *that hath* the plague: it is all turned white: he *is* **clean**.

Lev. 13:17 And the priest shall see him: and, behold, *if* the plague be turned into white; then the priest shall pronounce *him* **purified** (2891) *that has* the plague: he *is* **pure**.

Lev. 13:37 But if the scall in his sight is at a stay, and there is black hair grown up therein; the scall is healed, he *is* **pure**: and the priest shall pronounce him **purified** (2891).

Lev. 13:39 Then the priest shall look: and, behold, *if* the bright spots in the skin of their flesh *be* darkish white; it *is* a freckled spot *that* grows in the skin; he *is* **pure**.

Lev. 13:40 And the man whose hair has fallen off his head, he *is* bald; *yet is* he **pure**. Lev. 13:41 And he that hath his hair fallen off from the part of his head toward his face, he *is* forehead bald: *yet is* he **pure**.

Lev. 14:4 Then shall the priest command to take for him that is to be **purified (2891)** two birds alive *and* **pure**, and cedar wood, and scarlet, and hyssop:

Lev. 14:57 To teach when *it is* **defiled (2931)**, and when *it is* **pure**: this *is* the law of leprosy.

Lev. 15:8 And if he that has the seminal issue spit upon him that is **pure**; then he shall wash his clothes, and bathe *himself* in water, and be **defiled (2930)** until the even.

Lev. 20:25 You shall therefore distinguish between **pure** beasts and **defiled (2931)**, and between **defiled (2931)** fowls and **pure**: and you shall not make your beings detestable by beast, or by fowl, or by any manner of living thing that creeps on the ground, which I have distinguished to you as **defiled (2930)**.

Lev. 24:4 He shall order the lamps upon the **pure** candlestick before YAHWEH continually.

Lev. 24:6 And you shall set them in two rows, six on a row, upon the **pure** table before YAHWEH.

Num. 5:28 And if the woman is not **defiled (2930)**, but be **pure**; then she shall be free, and shall conceive seed.

Num. 9:13 But the man that *is* **pure**, and is not in a journey, and forbears to keep the passover, even the same being shall be cut off from among his people: because he brought not the offering of YAHWEH in His appointed season, that man shall bear his sin.

Num. 18:11 And this *is* yours; the heave offering of their gift, with all the wave offerings of the children of Israel: I have given them to you, and to your sons and to your daughters with you by a statute for ever: every one that is **pure** in your house shall eat of it.

Num. 18:13 *And* whatsoever is first ripe in the land, which they shall bring to YAHWEH, shall be yours; every one that is **pure** in your house shall eat *of* it.

Num. 19:9 And a man *that is* **pure** shall gather up the ashes of the heifer, and lay *them* up outside the camp in a **pure** place, and it shall be kept for the congregation of the children of Israel for a water of **rejection (5079**): it *is* a **sin offering (2403)**.

Num. 19:18 And a **pure** person shall take hyssop, and dip *it* in the water, and sprinkle *it* upon the tent, and upon all the vessels, and upon the persons that were there, and upon him that touched a bone, or one slain, or one dead, or a grave:

Num. 19:19 And the **pure** *person* shall sprinkle upon the **defiled (2930)** on the third day, and on the seventh day: and on the seventh day he shall **purify (2398 - by a sin offering)** himself, and wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and shall be **purified (2891)** at evening.

Deut. 12:15 Notwithstanding you may kill and eat flesh in all your gates, whatsoever your being longs after, according to the blessing of YAHWEH, your Elohim, which He has given you: the **defiled (2931)** and the **clean** may eat thereof, as of the roebuck, and as of the hart.

Deut. 12:22 Even as the roebuck and the hart is eaten, so you shall eat them: the **defiled (2931)** and the **clean** shall eat *of* them alike.

Deut. 14:11 Of all **pure** birds you shall eat.

Deut. 14:20 But of all pure fowls you may eat.

Deut. 15:22 You shall eat it within your gates: the **defiled (2931)** and the **clean** *person shall eat it* alike, as the roebuck, and as the hart.

Deut. 23:10 If there is among you any man that is not **pure** by reason of accidental occurrence upon him by night, then shall he go abroad out of the camp, he shall not come within the camp:

1Sam. 20:26 Nevertheless Saul spoke not any thing that day: for he thought, Something has befallen him, he *is* not **pure**; surely he *is* not **pure**.

1Chr. 28:17 Also **pure** gold for the fleshhooks, and the bowls, and the cups: and for the golden basons *he gave gold* by weight for every bason; and *likewise silver* by weight for every bason of silver:

2Chr. 3:4 And the porch that *was* in the front *of the house*, the length *of it was* according to the breadth of the house, twenty cubits, and the height *was* an hundred and twenty: and he overlaid it within with **pure** gold.

2Chr. 9:17 Moreover the king made a great throne of ivory, and overlaid it with **pure** gold.

2Chr. 13:11 And they burn unto YAHWEH every morning and every evening burnt sacrifices and sweet incense: the showbread also *they set in order* upon the **pure** table; and the candlestick of gold with the lamps thereof, to burn every evening: for we keep the charge of YAHWEH, our Elohim, but you have forsaken Him.

2Chr. 30:17 For *there were* many in the congregation that were not sanctified: therefore the Levites had the charge of the killing of the passovers for every one *that was* not **pure**, to sanctify *them* to YAHWEH.

Ezra 6:20 For the priests and the Levites were **purified (2891)** together, all of them *were* **pure**, and killed the passover for all the children of the captivity, and for their brethren the priests, and for themselves.

Job 14:4 Who can bring a **pure** *thing* out of a **defiled thing (2931)**? Not one.

Job 28:19 The topaz of Ethiopia shall not equal it, neither shall it be valued with **pure** gold.

Psa. 12:6 The words of YAHWEH *are* **pure** words: *as* silver refined in a furnace of earth, **refined (2212)** seven times.

Psa. 19:9 The fear of YAHWEH *is* **pure**, enduring for ever: the judgments of YAHWEH *are* true *and* just altogether.

Psa. 51:10 Create in me a **pure** heart, O Elohim; and renew an upright vital essence within me.

Prov. 15:26 The thoughts of the wicked *are* an abhorrence to YAHWEH: but *the words* of the **pure** *are* pleasant words.

Prov. 22:11 He that loves **purity (2890)** of heart, *for* the grace of his lips the king *shall be* his friend.

Prov. 30:12 *There is* a generation *that are* **pure** in their own eyes, and *yet* is not washed from their **excrement**.

Eccl. 9:2 All *things come* alike to all: *there is* one event to the just, and to the morally wrong; to the good and to the **pure**, and to the **defiled (2931)**; to him that sacrifices, and to him that sacrifices not: as *is* the good, so *is* the sinner; *and* he that swears, as *he* that fears an oath.

Is. 66:20 And they shall bring all your brethren *for* an offering unto YAHWEH out of all nations upon horses, and in chariots, and in litters, and upon mules, and upon swift beasts, to My holy mountain Jerusalem, says YAHWEH, as the children of Israel bring an offering in a **pure** vessel into the house of YAHWEH.

Ezek. 22:26 Her priests have violated My law, and have profaned My holy things: they have put no difference between the holy and profane, neither have they showed *a difference* between the **defiled (2931)** and the **pure**, and have hidden their eyes from My sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.

Ezek. 36:25 Then will I sprinkle **pure** water upon you, and you shall be **purified (2891)**: from all your **religious impurity (2932 - defilement)**, and from all your idols, will I **purify (2891)** you.

Ezek. 44:23 And they shall teach My people *the difference* between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the **defiled (2931)** and the **pure**.

Hab. 1:13 *You art* of **purer** eyes than to behold evil, and cannot look on iniquity: therefore you look upon them that deal treacherously, *and* hold your tongue when the wicked devours *the man that is* more just than he?

Zech. 3:5 And I said, Let them set a **pure** mitre upon his head. So they set a **pure** mitre upon his head, and clothed him with garments. And the angel of YAHWEH stood by.

Mal. 1:11 For from the rising of the sun even unto the going down of the same My name *shall be* great among the Gentiles; and in every place incense *shall be* offered unto My name, and a **pure** offering: for My name *shall be* great among the heathen, says YAHWEH of Assemblies.

# H2890 - purity - [Undefiled]

Job 17:9 The just shall also hold on his way, and he that has **pure** hands shall be stronger and stronger.

Prov. 22:11 He that loves **purity** of heart, *for* the favor of his lips the king *shall be* his friend.

# H2891 - to be pure - [Undefiled]

Gen. 35:2 And Jacob said to his household and to all who *were* with him, "Put away the foreign gods that *are* among you, **undefile (2891)** yourselves, and change your garments.

This is the first usage of 2891. Properly it means to be bright - pure, or unadulterated. To cleanse yourself misses the concept of becoming undefiled. It merely suggests something on the order of taking a bath/washing. But such "cleansing" does not make you undefiled.

What makes you undefiled is doing the will of YAHWEH - doing what is right in His "eyes" (in what He observes).

While there was often a ritual washing involved in Hebrew worship practices it is not the washing of the exterior that makes one undefiled. It is a symbolic act, much the same as baptism.

The water cannot remove the defilement

because every defilement

is related to one's relationship with YAHWEH

- as noted in the opening paragraphs above.

Lev. 11:32 And upon whatever *any* of them, when they are dead, does fall, it shall be **defiled (2930)**; whether *it is* any vessel of wood, or raiment, or skin, or sack, whatever vessel *it is*, wherein *any* work is done, it must be put into water, and it shall be **defiled (2930)** until the evening; so it shall be **purified**.

Lev. 12:7 Who shall offer it before YAHWEH, and make an atonement for her; and she shall be **purified** from the issue of her blood. This *is* the law for her that has born a male or a female.

Lev. 12:8 And if she is not able to bring a lamb, then she shall bring two turtles, or two young pigeons; the one for the burnt offering, and the other for a sin offering: and the priest shall make an atonement for her, and she shall be **purified**.

Lev. 13:6 And the priest shall look at him again the seventh day: and, behold, *if* the plague *is* somewhat dark, *and* the plague spread not in the skin, the priest shall pronounce him **purified**: it *is but* a scab: and he shall wash his clothes, and be **purified**.

Lev. 13:13 Then the priest shall consider: and, behold, *if* the leprosy has covered all his flesh, he shall pronounce *him* **purified** *that hath* the plague: it is all turned white: he *is* **pure (2889)**.

Lev. 13:17 And the priest shall see him: and, behold, *if* the plague is turned into white; then the priest shall pronounce *him* **purified** *that hath* the plague: he *is* **pure (2889)**.

Lev. 13:23 But if the bright spot stays in its place, *and* spreads not, it *is* a burning boil; and the priest shall pronounce him **purified**.

Lev. 13:28 And if the bright spot stays in its place, *and* spreads not in the skin, but it is somewhat dark; it *is* a rising of the burning, and the priest shall pronounce him **purified**: for it *is* an inflammation of the burning.

Lev. 13:34 And on the seventh day the priest shall look on the scall: and, behold, *if* the scall has not spread in the skin, nor *is* in sight deeper than the skin; then the priest shall pronounce him **clean**: and he shall wash his clothes, and be **clean**.

Lev. 13:37 But if the scall be in his sight at a stay, and there is black hair grown up therein; the scall is healed, he *is* **pure (2889)**: and the priest shall pronounce him **purified**.

Lev. 13:58 And the garment, either warp, or woof, or whatsoever thing of skin *it is*, which you shall wash, if the plague has departed from them, then it shall be washed the second time, and shall be **purified**.

Lev. 13:59 This *is* the law of the plague of leprosy in a garment of woollen or linen, either in the warp, or woof, or any thing of skins, to pronounce it **purified**, or to pronounce it **defiled (2930)**.

Lev. 14:4 Then shall the priest command to take for him that is to be **purified** two birds alive *and* **pure (2889)**, and cedar wood, and scarlet, and hyssop:

Lev. 14:7 And he shall sprinkle upon him that is to be **purified** from the leprosy seven times, and shall pronounce him **purified**, and shall let the living bird loose into the open field.

Lev. 14:8 And he that is to be **purified** shall wash his clothes, and shave off all his hair, and wash himself in water, that he may be **purified**: and after that he shall come into the camp, and shall tarry abroad out of his tent seven days.

Lev. 14:9 But it shall be on the seventh day, that he shall shave all his hair off his head and his beard and his eyebrows, even all his hair he shall shave off: and he shall wash his clothes, also he shall wash his flesh in water, and he shall be **purified**.

Lev. 14:11 And the priest that makes *him* **purified** shall present the man that is to be **purified**, and those things, before YAHWEH, *at* the door of the tabernacle of the congregation:

Lev. 14:14 And the priest shall take *some* of the blood of the trespass offering, and the priest shall put *it* upon the tip of the right ear of him that is to be **purified**, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right foot:

Lev. 14:17 And of the rest of the oil that *is* in his hand shall the priest put upon the tip of the right ear of him that is to be **purified**, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right foot, upon the blood of the trespass offering:

Lev. 14:18 And the remnant of the oil that *is* in the priest's hand he shall pour upon the head of him that is to be **purified**: and the priest shall make an atonement for him before YAHWEH.

Lev. 14:19 And the priest shall offer the sin offering, and make an atonement for him that is to be **purified** from his **defilement (2932)**; and afterward he shall kill the burnt offering:

Lev. 14:20 And the priest shall offer the burnt offering and the meat offering upon the altar: and the priest shall make an atonement for him, and he shall be **purified**.

Lev. 14:25 And he shall kill the lamb of the trespass offering, and the priest shall take *some* of the blood of the trespass offering, and put *it* upon the tip of the right ear of him that is to be **purified**, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right foot:

Lev. 14:28 And the priest shall put of the oil that *is* in his hand upon the tip of the right ear of him that is to be **purified**, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right foot, upon the place of the blood of the trespass offering: Lev. 14:29 And the rest of the oil that *is* in the priest's hand he shall put upon the head of him that is to be **purified**, to make an atonement for him before YAHWEH.

Lev. 14:31 *Even* such as he is able to get, the one *for* a sin offering, and the other *for* a burnt offering, with the meat offering: and the priest shall make an atonement for him that is to be **purified** before YAHWEH.

Lev. 14:48 And if the priest shall come in, and look *upon it*, and, behold, the plague has not spread in the house, after the house was plastered: then the priest shall pronounce the house **purified**, because the plague is healed.

Lev. 14:53 But he shall let go the living bird out of the city into the open fields, and make an atonement for the house: and it shall be **purified**.

Lev. 15:13 And when he that hath an issue is **purified** of his seminal discharge; then he shall number to himself seven days for his **purification (2893)**, and wash his clothes, and bathe his flesh in running water, and shall be **purified**.

Lev. 15:28 But if she is **purified** of her mesntrual discharge, then she shall number to herself seven days, and after that she shall be **purified**.

Lev. 16:19 And he shall sprinkle of the blood upon it with his finger seven times, and **purify** it, and hallow it from the **defilement (2932)** of the children of Israel.

Lev. 16:30 For on that day shall *the priest* make an atonement for you, to **purify** you, *that* you may be **purified** from all your sins before YAHWEH.

Lev. 17:15 And every being that eats that which died *of itself*, or that which was torn *with beasts, whether it be* one of your own country, or a stranger, he shall both wash his clothes, and bathe *himself* in water, and be **defiled (2930)** until the evening: then shall he be **purified**.

Lev. 22:4 What man whatever of the seed of Aaron *is* a leper, or has a seminal discharge; he shall not eat of the holy things, until he is **purified**. And whosever touches any thing *that is* **defiled (2931)** *by* the dead, or a man whose seed goes from him;

Lev. 22:7 And when the sun is down, he shall be **purified**, and shall afterward eat of the holy things; because it *is* his food.

Num. 8:6 Take the Levites from among the children of Israel, and **purify** them. Num. 8:7 And thus shall you do to them to **purify** them: Sprinkle **water of satisfaction** (2403 - from the sin offering) upon them, and let them shave all their flesh, and let them wash their clothes, and *so* make themselves **purified**.

Num. 8:15 And after that shall the Levites go in to do the service of the tabernacle of the congregation: and thou shalt **cleanse** them, and offer them *for* an offering.

Num. 8:21 And the Levites were purified, and they washed their clothes; and Aaron offered them *as* an offering before YAHWEH; and Aaron made an atonement for them to **purify** them.

Num. 19:12 He shall **purify (2398 - by sin offering)** himself with it on the third day, and on the seventh day he shall be **purified**: but if he does not **purify (2398 - by sin offering)** himself the third day, then the seventh day he shall not be **purified**.

Num. 19:19 And the **pure (2889)** *person* shall sprinkle upon the **defiled (2931)** on the third day, and on the seventh day: and on the seventh day he shall **purify (2398 - by sin offering)** himself, and wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and shall be **purified** at evening.

Num. 31:23 Every thing that may enduree the fire, you shall make *it* go through the fire, and it shall be **purified**: nevertheless it shall be **purified with the water of rejection** (5079): and all that does not endure the fire you shall make go through the water. Num. 31:24 And you shall wash your clothes on the seventh day, and you shall be **purified**, and afterward you shall come into the camp.

Josh. 22:17 *Is* the iniquity of Peor too little for us, from which we are not **purified** until this day, although there was a plague in the congregation of YAHWEH,

2Kings 5:10 And Elisha sent a messenger unto him, saying, Go and wash in Jordan seven times, and thy flesh shall come again to you, and you shall be **purified**.

2Kings 5:12 *Are* not Abana and Pharpar, rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? may I not wash in them, and be **purified**? So he turned and went away in a rage.

2Kings 5:13 And his servants came near, and spoke unto him, and said, My father, *if* the prophet had asked you to *do some* great thing, would you not have done *it*? How much rather then, when he says to you, Wash, and be **purified**?

2Kings 5:14 Then went he down, and dipped himself seven times in Jordan, according to the saying of the man of The Elohim: and his flesh came again like unto the flesh of a little child, and he was **purified**.

2Chr. 29:15 And they gathered their brethren, and sanctified themselves, and came, according to the commandment of the king, by the words of YAHWEH, to **purify** the house of YAHWEH.

2Chr. 29:16 And the priests went into the inner part of the house of YAHWEH, to **purify** *it*, and brought out all the **defilement (2932)** that they found in the temple of YAHWEH into the court of the house of YAHWEH. And the Levites took *it*, to carry *it* out abroad into the brook Kidron.

2Chr. 29:18 Then they went in to Hezekiah the king, and said, We have **purified** all the house of YAHWEH, and the altar of burnt offering, with all the vessels thereof, and the showbread table, with all the vessels thereof.

2Chr. 30:18 For a multitude of the people, *even* many of Ephraim, and Manasseh, Issachar, and Zebulun, had not **purified** themselves, yet they at the passover otherwise than it was written. But Hezekiah prayed for them, saying, The good YAHWEH pardon every one

2Chr. 34:3 For in the eighth year of his reign, while he was yet young, he began to seek after the Elohim of David his father: and in the twelfth year he began to **purified** Judah and Jerusalem from the high places, and the groves, and the carved images, and the molten images.

2Chr. 34:5 And he burnt the bones of the priests upon their altars, and **purified** Judah and Jerusalem.

2Chr. 34:8 Now in the eighteenth year of his reign, when he had **purified** the land, and the house, he sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, and Maaseiah the governor of the city, and Joah the son of Joahaz the recorder, to repair the house of YAHWEH, his Elohim.

Ezra 6:20 For the priests and the Levites were **purified** together, all of them *were* **pure (2889)**, and killed the passover for all the children of the captivity, and for their brethren the priests, and for themselves.

Neh. 12:30 And the priests and the Levites **purified** themselves, and **purified** the people, and the gates, and the wall.

Neh. 13:9 Then I commanded, and they **purified** the chambers: and there I brought again the vessels of the house of The Elohim, with the meat offering and the frankincense.

Neh. 13:22 And I commanded the Levites that they should **purify** themselves, and *that* they should come *and* keep the gates, to sanctify the sabbath day. Remember me, O my Elohim, *concerning* this also, and spare me according to the greatness of your kindness.

Neh. 13:30 Thus I **purified** them from all strangers, and appointed the wards of the priests and the Levites, every one in his business;

Job 4:17 Shall mortal man be more just than God? shall a man be more **purified** than his maker?

Job 37:21 And now *men* see not the bright light which *is* in the clouds: but the wind passes and **purifies** them.

Psa. 51:2 Wash me throughly from my iniquity, and **purifiy** me from my sin.

Psa. 51:7 **Purify (2398 - by the sin offering)** me with hyssop, and I shall be **purified**: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

Prov. 20:9 Who can say, I have made my heart clean, I am purified from my sin?

Is. 66:17 They that sanctify themselves, and **purify** themselves in the gardens behind one *tree* in the midst, eating swine's flesh, and the abomination, and the mouse, shall be consumed together, says YAHWEH.

Jer. 13:27 I have seen your adulteries, and your neighings, the lewdness of your whoredom, *and* your abominations on the hills in the fields. Woe to you, O Jerusalem! Will you not be **purified**? When *shall it* once *be*?

Jer. 33:8 And I will **purify** them from all their iniquity, whereby they have sinned against Me; and I will pardon all their iniquities, whereby they have sinned, and whereby they have transgressed against Me.

Ezek. 22:24 Son of man, say unto her, You *are* the land that is not **purified**, nor rained upon in the day of indignation.

Ezek. 24:13 In your **defilement (2932)** *is* lewdness: because I have **purified** you, and you were not **purified**, you shall not be **purified** from your **defilement (2932)** any more, until have caused My fury to rest upon you.

Ezek. 36:25 Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and you shall be **purified**: from all your **defilement (2932)**, and from all your idols, will I **purify** you.

Ezek. 36:33 Thus says YAHWEH Elohim; In the day that I shall have **purified** you from all your iniquities I will also cause *you* to dwell in the cities, and the wastes shall be builded.

Ezek. 37:23 Neither shall they **defile (2930)** themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions: but I will save them out of all their dwelling places, wherein they have sinned, and will **purify** them: so shall they be My people, and I will be their Elohim.

Ezek. 39:12 And seven months shall the house of Israel be burying of them, that they may **purify** the land.

Ezek. 39:14 And they shall sever out men of continual employment, passing through the land to bury with the passengers those that remain upon the face of the earth, to **purify** it: after the end of seven months shall they search.

Ezek. 39:16 And also the name of the city *shall be* Hamonah. Thus shall they **purify** the land.

Ezek. 43:26 Seven days shall they make atonement for the altar and **purify** it; and they shall consecrate themselves.

Mal. 3:3 And He shall sit *as* a refiner and **purifier** of silver: and he shall **purify** the sons of Levi, and **refine (2212)** them as gold and silver, that they may offer unto YAHWEH an offering in righteousness.

### H2892 - clearness, purification - [Undefiled]

Ex. 24:10 And they saw The Elohim of Israel: and *there was* under His feet as it were a paved work of a sapphire stone, and as it were the body of heaven in *its* **purity**.

Lev. 12:4 And she shall then continue in the blood of her **purification (22893)** three and thirty days; she shall touch no hallowed thing, nor come into the sanctuary, until the days of her **purification** be fulfilled.

Lev. 12:6 And when the days of her **purification** are fulfilled, for a son, or for a daughter, she shall bring a lamb of the first year for a burnt offering, and a young pigeon, or a turtledove, for a sin offering, unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, unto the priest:

Psa. 89:44 You have made his **purity** to cease, and cast his throne down to the ground.

### H2893 - purification - [Undefiled]

Lev. 12:4 And she shall then continue in the blood of her **purification (22893)** three and thirty days; she shall touch no hallowed thing, nor come into the sanctuary, until the days of her **purification** be fulfilled.

Lev. 12:5 But if she bears a maid child, then she shall be unclean two weeks, as in her separation: and she shall continue in the blood of her **purification** threescore and six days.

Lev. 13:7 But if the scab spreads much abroad in the skin, after he has been seen by the priest for his **purification**, he shall be seen by the priest again:

Lev. 13:35 But if the scall spread much in the skin after his purification;

Lev. 14:2 This shall be the law of the leper in the day of his **purification**: He shall be brought unto the priest:

Lev. 14:23 And he shall bring them on the eighth day for his **purification** unto the priest, unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, before YAHWEH.

Lev. 14:32 This *is* the law *of him* in whom *is* the plague of leprosy, whose hand is not able to get *that which pertains* to his **purification**.

Lev. 15:13 And when he that has a semnal issue is **purified (2891)** of his issue; then he shall number to himself seven days for his **purification**, and wash his clothes, and bathe his flesh in running water, and shall be **purified (2891)**.

Num. 6:9 And if any man dies very suddenly by him, and he has **defiled (2930)** the head of his consecration; then he shall shave his head in the day of his **purification**, on the seventh day shall he shave it.

1Chr. 23:28 Because their office *was* to wait on the sons of Aaron for the service of the house of YAHWEH, in the courts, and in the chambers, and in the **purification** of all holy things, and the work of the service of the house of The Elohim;

2Chr. 30:19 *That* prepares his heart to seekThe Elohim, YAHWEH, The Elohim of his fathers, though *he is* not *purified* according to the **purification** of the sanctuary.

Neh. 12:45 And both the singers and the porters kept the ward of their God, and the ward of the **purification**, according to the commandment of David, *and* of Solomon his son.

Ezek. 44:26 And after his **purification**, they shall reckon unto him seven days.

#### H2930 - defile

Occurs 161 times, many of which have already been seen in the preceding verses. A list is not included for these.

### H2931 - defiled

Lev. 5:2 Or if a being touches any **defiled** thing, whether *it be* a carcass of a **defiled** creature, or a carcass of a **defiled** beast, or the carcass of **defiled** swarming things, and *if* it is hidden from him; he also shall be **defiled**, and guilty.

Lev. 7:19 And the flesh that touches any **defiled** *thing* shall not be eaten; it shall be burnt with fire: and as for the flesh, all that are **pure** (2889) shall eat thereof.

Lev. 7:21 Moreover the being that shall touch any **defiled** *thing, as* the **defilement** (2932) of man, or *any* **defiled** beast, or any detestable **defiled** *thing*, and eats of the flesh of the sacrifice of peace offerings, which *pertain* unto YAHWEH, even that being shall be cut off from his people.

Lev. 10:10 And that you may make a distinction between holy and unholy, and between **defiled** and **pure (2889)**;

Lev. 11:4 Nevertheless these you shall not eat of them that chew the cud, or of them that divide the hoof: *as* the camel, because he chews the cud, but divides not the hoof; he *is* **defiled** to you.

Lev. 11:5 And the coney, because he chews the cud, but divides not the hoof; he *is* **defiled** unto you.

Lev. 11:6 And the hare, because he chews the cud, but divides not the hoof; he *is* **defiled** unto you.

Lev. 11:7 And the swine, though he divides the hoof, and is clovenfooted, yet he chews not the cud; he *is* **defiled** to you.

Lev. 11:8 Of their flesh you shall not eat, and their carcass you shall not touch; they *are* **defiled** to you.

Lev. 11:26 *The carcasses* of every beast which divides the hoof, and *is* not clovenfooted, nor chews the cud, *are* **defiled** unto you: every one that toucheth them shall be unclean. Lev. 11:27 And whatsoever goeth upon his paws, among all manner of beasts that go on *all* four, those *are* **defiled** unto you: whoever touches their carcass shall be **defiled** (2930) until the evening.

Lev. 11:28 And he that bears the carcass of them shall wash his clothes, and be **defiled** (2930) until the evening: they *are* **defiled** unto you.

Lev. 11:29 These also *shall be* **defiled** to you among the swarming things that cswarm upon the earth; the weasel, and the mouse, and the tortoise after his kind,

Lev. 11:31 These *are* **defiled** to you among all that swarm: whoever touches them, when they be dead, shall be **defiled (2930)** until the evening.

Lev. 11:35 And every *thing* whereon *any part* of their carcass falls shall be **defiled** (2930); *whether it be* oven, or ranges for pots, they shall be broken down: *for* they *are* **defiled**, and shall be **defiled** unto you.

Lev. 11:38 But if *any* water be put upon the seed, and *any part* of their carcass falls thereon, it *shall be* **defiled** unto you.

Lev. 11:47 To make a distinction the **defiled** and the **pure (2889)**, and between the beast that may be eaten and the beast that may not be eaten.

Lev. 13:11 It *is* an old leprosy in the skin of his flesh, and the priest shall pronounce him **defiled (2930)**, and shall not shut him up: for he *is* **defiled**.

Lev. 13:15 And the priest shall see the raw flesh, and pronounce him to be **defiled** (2930): *for* the raw flesh *is* **defiled**: it *is* a leprosy.

Lev. 13:36 Then the priest shall look on him: and, behold, if the scall has spread in the skin, the priest shall not seek for yellow hair; he *is* **defiled**.

Lev. 13:44 He is a leprous man, he *is* **defiled**: the priest shall pronounce him utterly **defiled** (2930); his plague *is* in his head.

Lev. 13:45 And the leper in whom the plague *is*, his clothes shall be rent, and his head bare, and he shall put a covering upon his upper lip, and shall cry, **Defiled**, **defiled**. Lev. 13:46 All the days wherein the plague *shall be* in him he shall be **defiled (2930)**; he *is* unclean: he shall dwell alone; outside the camp *shall* his habitation *be*.

Lev. 13:51 And he shall look on the plague on the seventh day: if the plague be spread in the garment, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in a skin, *or* in any work that is made of skin; the plague *is* a fretting leprosy; it *is* **defiled**.

Lev. 13:55 And the priest shall look on the plague, after it is washed: and, behold, *if* the plague has not changed its color, and the plague has not spread; it *is* **defiled**; you shall burn it in the fire; it *is* fret inward, *whether* it *be* bare within or without.

Lev. 14:40 Then the priest shall command that they take away the stones in which the plague *is*, and they shall cast them into an **defiled** place without the city: Lev. 14:41 And he shall cause the house to be scraped within round about, and they shall pour out the dust that they scrape off without the city into an **defiled** place:

Lev. 14:44 Then the priest shall come and look, and, behold, *if* the plague has spread in the house, it *is* a fretting leprosy in the house: it *is* **defiled**.

Lev. 14:45 And he shall break down the house, the stones of it, and the timber thereof, and all the mortar of the house; and he shall carry *them* forth out of the city into an **defiled** place.

Lev. 14:57 To teach when *it is* **defiled**, and when *it is* **pure (2889)**: this *is* the law of leprosy.

Lev. 15:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When any man has a seminal discharge out of his flesh, *because of* his seminal discharge he *is* **defiled**.

Lev. 15:25 And if a woman have an discharge of her blood many days out of the time of her **rejection (5079)**, or if it runs beyond the time of her **rejections (5079)**; all the days of the discharge of her **defilement (2932)** shall be as the days of her **rejection (5079)**: she *shall be* **defiled**.

Lev. 15:26 Every bed whereon she liis all the days of her discharge shall be to her as the bed of her **rejection (5079)**: and whatever she sits upon shall be **defiled**, as the **defilement (2932)** of her **rejection (5079)**.

Lev. 15:33 And of her that is **sick (1739)** of her **rejection (5079)**, and of him that has a seminal discharge, of the man, and of the woman, and of him that lies with her that is **defiled**.

Lev. 20:25 You shall therefore distinguish between **pure (2889)** beasts and **defiled**, and between **defiled** fowls and **pure (2889)**: and you shall not make your beings detestable by beast, or by fowl, or by any manner of living thing that swarms on the ground, which I have separated from you as **defiled (2930)**.

Lev. 22:4 Whatever man of the seed of Aaron *is* a leper, or hath a seminal issue; he shall not eat of the holy things, until he is **pure (2889)**. And whoever touches any thing *that is* **defiled** *by* the dead, or a man whose seed goes from him;

Lev. 27:11 And if *it be* any **defiled** beast, of which they do not offer a sacrifice unto YAHWEH, then he shall present the beast before the priest:

Lev. 27:27 And if *it be* of an **defiled** beast, then he shall redeem *it* according to your estimation, and shall add a fifth *part* of to it: or if it be not redeemed, then it shall be sold according to your estimation.

Num. 5:2 Command the children of Israel, that they put out of the camp every leper, and every one that hath an seminal discharge, and whosoever is **defiled** by the dead:

Num. 9:6 And there were certain men who were **defiled** by the dead body of a man so that they could not keep the passover on that day: and they came before Moses and before Aaron on that day:

Num. 9:7 And those men said unto him, We *are* **defiled** by the dead body of a man: why are we kept back, that we may not offer an offering of YAHWEH in his appointed season among the children of Israel?

Num. 9:10 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If any man of you or of your posterity shall be **defiled** by reason of a dead body, or *be* in a journey afar off, yet he shall keep the passover to YAHWEH.

Num. 18:15 Every thing that opens the matrix in all flesh, which they bring to YAHWEH, *whether it be* of men or beasts, shall be yours: nevertheless the firstborn of man shall you surely redeem, and the firstling of **defiled** beasts shall you redeem.

Num. 19:13 Whoever touches the dead body of any man that is dead, and **purifies** (2398 - by sin offering) not himself, defiles (2930) the tabernacle of YAHWEH; and that being shall be cut off from Israel: because the water of satisfaction (2403) was not sprinkled on him, he shall be defiled; his defilement (2932) *is* still on him.

Num. 19:15 And every open vessel, which has no covering bound upon it, *is* defiled.

Num. 19:17 And for a **defiled** *person* they shall take of the ashes of the burnt heifer of **satisfaction for sin (2403)**, and running water shall be put thereto in a vessel:

Num. 19:19 And the **pure (2889)** *person* shall sprinkle upon the **defiled** on the third day, and on the seventh day: and on the seventh day he shall **purify (2398 - by sin offering)** himself, and wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and shall be **pure (2889)** at evening.

Num. 19:20 But the man that is **defiled (2930)**, and does not **purify (2398 - by sin offering)** himself, that being shall be cut off from among the congregation, because he has **defiled (2930)** the sanctuary of YAHWEH: the **water of satisfaction (2304)** has not been sprinkled on him; he *is* **defiled**.

Num. 19:22 And whatever the **defiled** *person* touches shall be **defiled** (2930); and the being that touches *it* shall be **defiled** (2930) until evening.

Deut. 12:15 Notwithstanding you may kill and eat flesh in all your gates, whatever your being desires, according to the blessing of YAHWEH, your Elohim, which he has given you: the **defiled** and the **pure (2889)** may eat thereof, as of the roebuck, and as of the hart.

Deut. 12:22 Even as the roebuck and the hart is eaten, so you shall eat them: the **defiled** and the **pure (2889)** shall eat *of* them alike.

Deut. 14:7 Nevertheless these you shall not eat of them that chew the cud, or of them that divide the cloven hoof; *as* the camel, and the hare, and the coney: for they chew the cud, but divide not the hoof; *therefore* they *are* **defiled** unto you.

Deut. 14:8 And the swine, because it divides the hoof, yet chews not the cud, it *is* **defiled** unto you: you shall not eat of their flesh, nor touch their dead carcass. Deut. 14:10 And whatever has not fins and scales you may not eat; it *is* **defiled** to you.

Deut. 14:19 And every creeping thing that flies *is* **defiled** to you: they shall not be eaten.

Deut. 15:22 You shall eat it within your gates: the **defiled** and the **pure (2889)** person shall eat it alike, as the roebuck, and as the hart.

Deut. 26:14 I have not eaten thereof in my mourning, neither have I taken away *ought* thereof for *any* **unclean** *use*, nor given *ought* thereof for the dead: *but* I have hearkened to the voice of the LORD my God, *and* have done according to all that thou hast commanded me.

Josh. 22:19 Notwithstanding, if the land of your possession *is* **defiled**, *then* pass over to the land of the possession of YAHWEH, wherein YAHWEH's tabernacle dwells, and take possession among us: but rebel not against YAHWEH, nor rebel against us, in building an altar beside the altar of YAHWEH, our Elohim.

Judg. 13:4 Now therefore beware, I pray thee, and drink not wine nor strong drink, and eat not any **defiled** *thing*:

2Chr. 23:19 And he set the porters at the gates of the house of YAHWEH, that none *who were* **defiled** in any thing should enter in.

Job 14:4 Who can bring a **pure (2889)** *thing* out of a **defiled**? Not one.

Eccl. 9:2 All *things come* alike to all: *there is* one event to the just, and to the wicked; to the good and to the **pure (2889)**, and to the **defiled**; to him that sacrifices, and to him that sacrifices not: as *is* the good, so *is* the sinner; *and* he that swears, as *he* that fears an oath.

Is. 6:5 Then said I, Woe *is* me! for I am undone; because I *am* a man of **defiled** lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of **defiled** lips: for My eyes have seen The King, YAHWEH of Assemblies.

Is. 35:8 And a highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the **defiled** shall not pass over it; but it *shall be* for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err *therein*.

Is. 52:1 Awake, awake; put on thy strength, O Zion; put on thy beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city: for henceforth there shall no more come into you the uncircumcised and the **defiled**.

Is. 52:11 Depart, depart, go out from there. Touch no **defiled** *thing*; go out of the midst of her; be **pure** (2889), who bear the vessels of YAHWEH.

Is. 64:6 But we are all as a **defiled** *thing*, and all our right actions *are* as **menstrual (5708)** rags; and we all fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

Jer. 19:13 And the houses of Jerusalem, and the houses of the kings of Judah, shall be **defiled** as the place of Tophet, because of all the houses upon whose roofs they have

burned incense unto all the host of heaven, and have poured out drink offerings unto other gods.

Lam. 4:15 They cried unto them, Depart; *it is* **defiled**; depart, depart, touch not: when they fled away and wandered, they said among the heathen, They shall no more sojourn *there*.

Ezek. 4:13 And YAHWEH said, Even thus shall the children of Israel eat their **defiled** bread among the Gentiles, where I will drive them.

Ezek. 22:5 *Those thataree* near, and *those that are* far from you, shall mock you, *which art* **defiled** *and* greatly panicked.

Ezek. 22:10 In you have they discovered their fathers' nakedness: in you have they humbled her that was set apart for the sake of **defilement**.

Ezek. 22:26 Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned My holy things: they have put no distinction between the holy and profane, neither have they showed *a distinction* between the **defiled** and the **pure (2889)**, and have hidden their eyes from My sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.

Ezek. 44:23 And they shall teach My people *the distinction* between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the **defiled** and the **pure (2889)**.

Hos. 9:3 They shall not dwell in YAHWEH's land; but Ephraim shall return to Egypt, and they shall eat **defiled** *things* in Assyria.

Amos 7:17 Therefore thus says YAHWEH; Your wife shall be a harlot in the city, and your sons and your daughters shall fall by the sword, and your land shall be divided by line; and you shall die in a **defiled** land: and Israel shall surely go forth into captivity from his land.

Hag. 2:13 Then said Haggai, If *one that is* **defiled** by a dead body touches any of these, shall it be **defiled (2930)**? And the priests answered and said, It shall be **defiled (2930)**. Hag. 2:14 Then answered Haggai, and said, So *is* this people, and so *is* this nation before Me, says YAHWEH; and so *is* every work of their hands; and that which they offer there *is* **defiled**.

### H 2932 - defilement

Lev. 5:3 Or if he touches the **defilement** of man, whatever **defilement** *it be* that a man shall be **defiled (2930)** with, and it be hidden from him; when he knows *of it*, then he shall be guilty.

Lev. 7:20 But the being that eats *of* the flesh of the sacrifice of peace offerings, that *pertain* unto YAHWEH, having his **defilement** upon him, even that being shall be cut off from his people.

Lev. 7:21 Moreover the being that shall touch any **defiled (2931)** *thing, as* the **defilement** of man, or *any* **defiled (2931)** beast, or any detestable **defiled (2930)** *thing,* and eat of the flesh of the sacrifice of peace offerings, which *pertain* to YAHWEH, even that being shall be cut off from his people.

Lev. 14:19 And the priest shall offer the sin offering, and make an atonement for him that is to be **purified** from his **defilement**; and afterward he shall kill the burnt offering:

Lev. 15:3 And this shall be his **defilement** in his discharge: whether his flesh run with his discharge, or his flesh be stopped from his discharge, it *is* his **defilement**.

Lev. 15:25 And if a woman have andischarge of her blood many days out of the time of her **rejection (5079)**, or if it runs beyond the time of her **rejection (5079)**; all the days of the discharge of her **defilement** shall be as the days of her **rejection (5079)**: she *shall be* **defiled (2930)**.

Lev. 15:26 Every bed on which she liesall the days of her discharge shall be to her as the bed of her **rejection (5079)**: and whatever she sits upon shall be **defiled (2931)**, as the **defilement** of her**rejection (5079)**.

Lev. 15:30 And the priest shall offer the one *for* a sin offering, and the other *for* a burnt offering; and the priest shall make an atonement for her before YAHWEH for the discharge of her **defilement**.

Lev. 15:31 Thus shall you separate the children of Israel from their **defilement**; that they die not in their **defilement**, when they **defile (2930)** My tabernacle that *is* among them.

Lev. 16:16 And he shall make an atonement for the holy *place*, because of the **defilement** of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions in all their sins: and so shall he do for the tabernacle of the congregation, that remains among them in the midst of their **defilement**.

Lev. 16:19 And he shall sprinkle of the blood upon it with his finger seven times, and **purify (2891)** it, and hallow it from the **defilement** of the children of Israel.

Lev. 18:19 Also you shall not approach a woman to uncover her nakedness, as long as she is put apart for her **defilement**.

Lev. 22:3 Say to them, Whoever *heise* of all your seed among your generations, that goes to the holy things, which the children of Israel hallow unto YAHWEH, having his **defilement** upon him, that being shall be cut off fromMmy presence: I *am* YAHWEH.

Lev. 22:5 Or whoever touches any swarming thing, whereby he may be made **defiled** (2930), or a man of whom he may take **defilement**, whatever **defilement** he has;

Num. 5:19 And the priest shall charge her by an oath, and say unto the woman, If no man has lain with you, and if you have not gone aside to **defilement** *with another* instead of thy husband, be free from this bitter water that causeth the curse:

Num. 19:13 Whosoever touches the dead body of any man that is dead, and **purifies** (2398 - by sin offering) not himself, defiles (2930) the tabernacle of YAHWEH; and that being shall be cut off from Israel: because the water of satisfaction (2403) was not sprinkled on him, he shall be defiled (2931); his defilement *is* still upon him.

Judg. 13:7 But he said to me, Behold, you shall conceive, and bear a son; and now drink no wine nor strong drink, neither eat any **defiled** *thing*: for the child shall be a Nazarite to The Elohim from the womb to the day of his death.

Judg. 13:14 She may not eat of any *thing* that comes of the vine, neither let her drink wine or strong drink, nor eat any **defiled** *thing*: all that I commanded her let her observe.

2Sam. 11:4 And David sent messengers, and took her; and she came in to him, and he lay with her; for she was **consecrated (6942)** from her **defilement**: and she returned unto her house.

2Chr. 29:16 And the priests went into the inner part of the house of YAHWEH, to **purify** (2891) *it*, and brought out all the **defilement** that they found in the temple of YAHWEH into the court of the house of YAHWEH. And the Levites took *it*, to carry *it* out abroad into the brook Kidron.

Ezra 6:21 And the children of Israel, which had come again out of captivity, and all such as had separated themselves unto them from the **defilement** of the heathen of the land, to seek YAHWEH, The Elohim of Israel, did eat,

Ezra 9:11 Which You have commanded by Your servants the prophets, saying, The land, to which you go to possess it, is an **rejected (5079)** land with the **rejection (5079)** of the people of the lands, with their abominations, who have filled it from one end to another with their **defilement**.

Lam. 1:9 Her **defilement** *is* in her skirts; she remembers not her last end; therefore she came down wonderfully: she had no comforter. O YAHWEH, behold my affliction: for the enemy has magnified *himself*.

Ezek. 22:15 And I will scatter you among the heathen, and disperse you in the countries, and will consume thy **defilement** out of you.

Ezek. 24:11 Then set it empty upon the coals thereof, that the brass of it may be hot, and may burn, and *that* the **defilement** of it may be melted in it, *that* the scum of it may be consumed.

Ezek. 24:13 In your **defilement** *is* lewdness: because I have **purified (2891)** you, and you were not **purified (2891)**, you shall not be **purified (2891)** from your **defilement** any more, untill have caused My fury to rest upon you.

Ezek. 36:17 Son of man, when the house of Israel dwelled in their own land, they **defiled (2930)** it by their own way and by their doings: their way was before Me as the **defilement** of a **rejected woman (5079)**.

Ezek. 36:25 Then will I sprinkle **pure (2889)** water upon you, and you shall be **pure (2889)**: from all your **defilement**, and from all your idols, will I **purify (2891)** you.

Ezek. 36:29 I will also save you from all your **defilement**: and I will call for the corn, and will increase it, and lay no famine upon you.

Ezek. 39:24 According to their **defilement** and according to their violations have I done to them, and hid My face from them.

Zech. 13:2 And it shall come to pass in that day, says YAHWEH of Assemblies, *that* I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they shall no more be remembered: and also I will cause the prophets and the vital essence of **defilement** to pass out of the land.

# H2933 - defiled - impure in a religious sense

Lev. 11:43 You shall not make yourselves abominable with any creeping thing that creepeth, neither shall ye make yourselves unclean with them, that ye should be **defiled** thereby.

Job 18:3 Wherefore are we counted as beasts, and reputed vile in your sight?

# H4357 - complete - perfect - [Undefiled]

2Chr. 4:21 And the flowers, and the lamps, and the tongs, *made he of* gold, *and* that **perfect** gold;

# H4935 - inspect - cleanse in preparation for inspection - [Undefile]

Ezek. 16:4 And *as for* your nativity, in the day you were born your navel was not cut, neither were you washed in water to **inspect** *you*; you were not salted at all, nor swaddled at all.

# H5079 - rejection - [Defiled]

One is rejected because of the flow of blood, which causes **defilement**. Because of the defilement they are to be removed from the camp, separated. Perhaps a proper translation would be "defiled by menstrual flow". It appears to have been considered a major form of **defilement**.

Virtually all of the verses associated with this form of **defilement** have already been identified in the preceding verses, so they will not be repeated here. There are 29 occurrences.

# H5178 - copper, as a base (impure) metal - [Defiled]

Ezek. 16:36 Thus says YAHWEH Elohim; Because your **impurity** was poured out, and your nakedness discovered through your whoredoms with your lovers, and with all the idols of your abominations, and by the blood of your children, which you gave to them;

# H5343 - clean; uncontaminated - [Undefiled]

Dan. 7:9 I watched until the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days sat, whose garment *was* white as snow, and the hair of his head like **clean** wool: his throne *was like* the fiery flame, *and* his wheels *as* burning fire.

# H5352 - to be or make clean; innocent - [Undefiled]

Gen. 24:8 And if the woman will not be willing to follow you, then you shall be **innocent** from this my oath: only bring not my son there again.

Gen. 24:41 Then shall you be **innocent** from *this* my oath, when you come to my kindred; and if they give you not *one*, you shall be clear from my oath.

Ex. 20:7 You shalt not take the name of YAHWEH, your Elohim, in vain; for YAHWEH will not hold him **innocent** that takes His name in vain.

Ex. 21:19 If he rises again, and walks abroad upon his staff, then shall he that smote *him* be **innocent**: only he shall pay *for* the loss of his time, and shall cause *him* to be thoroughly healed.

Ex. 34:7 Keeping kindness for thousands, forgiving iniquity and violation and sin, and that will by no means **declare innocent** *the guilty*; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth *generation*.

Num. 5:19 And the priest shall charge her by an oath, and say unto the woman, If no man has laid with you, and if you have not gone aside to **defilement (2932)** with another instead of your husband, be **innocent** from this bitter water that causes the curse:

Num. 5:28 And if the woman is not **defiled (2930)**, but be **pure (2889)** then she shall be **innocent**, and shall conceive seed.

Num. 5:31 Then shall the man be **innocent** from iniquity, and this woman shall bear her iniquity.

Num. 14:18 YAHWEH *is* longsuffering, and of great kindness, forgiving iniquity and violation, and by no means **declaring innocent** *the guilty*, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation*.

Deut. 5:11 You shall not take the name of YAHWEH, your Elohim, in vain: for YAHWEH will not hold *him* **innocent** that taketh his name in vain.

Judg. 15:3 And Samson said concerning them, Now shall I be more **innocent** than the Philistines, though I do them a displeasure.

1Sam. 26:9 And David said to Abishai, Destroy him not: for who can stretch forth his hand against YAHWEH's anointed, and be **innocent**?

1Kings 2:9 Now therefore hold him not **innocent**: for you *are* a wise man, and know what thou ought to do to him; but his hoar head bring down to the grave with blood.

Job 9:28 I am afraid of all my sorrows, I know that You wilt not hold me **innocent**. Job 10:14 If I sin, then You mark me, and You will not **declare me innocent** from my iniquity.

Psa. 19:12 Who can understand his errors? Cleanse me from secret faults.

Psa. 19:13 Keep back your servant also from presumptuous *sins*; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be **cleansed** from the great violation.

Prov. 6:29 So he that goes in to his neighbor's wife; whoever touches her shall not be **innocent**.

Prov. 11:21 *Though* hand *join* in hand, the wicked shall not be **innocent**: but the seed of the just shall be delivered.

Prov. 16:5 Every one *that is* proud in heart *is* an abomination to YAHWEH: *though* hand *join* in hand, he shall not be **innocent**.

Prov. 17:5 Whoever mocks the poor reproaches his Maker: *and* he that is glad at calamities shall not be **innocent**.

Prov. 19:5 A false witness shall not be **innocent**, and *he that* speaks lies shall not escape.

Prov. 19:9 A false witness shall not be **innocent**, and *he that* speaks lies shall perish.

Prov. 28:20 A faithful man shall abound with blessings: but he that makes haste to be rich shall not be **innocent**.

Is. 3:26 And her gates shall lament and mourn; and she *being* **innocent** shall sit upon the ground.

Jer. 2:35 Yet thou sayest, Because I am **innocent**, surely his anger shall turn from me. Behold, I will plead with thee, because thou sayest, I have not sinned.

Jer. 25:29 For, lo, I begin to bring evil on the city which is called by My name, and should you be **utterly innocent**? You shall not be **innocent**: for I will call for a sword upon all the inhabitants of the earth, says YAHWEH of Assemblies.

Jer. 30:11 For I *am* with you, says YAHWEH, to save you: though I make a full end of all nations where I have scattered you, yet will I not make a full end of you: but I will correct you in measure, and will not leave thee **utterly innocent**.

Jer. 46:28 Fear not, O Jacob my servant, says YAHWEH, for I *am* with you; for I will make a full end of all the nations where I have driven you: but I will not make a full end of you, but correct you in measure; yet will I not leave you **utterly innocent**.

Jer. 49:12 For thus says YAHWEH; Behold, they whose judgment *was* not to drink of the cup have assuredly drunk; and *are* you he *that* shall be **utterly innocent**? You shall not be **innocent**, but you shalt surely drink *of it*.

Joel 3:21 For I will **cleanse** their blood *that* I have not **cleansed**: for YAHWEH dwells in Zion.

Nah. 1:3 YAHWEH *is* slow to anger, and great in power, and will not at **declare innocent** *the wicked*: YAHWEH has His way in the whirlwind and in the storm, and the clouds *are* the dust of his feet.

Zech. 5:3 Then said he to me, This *is* the curse that goes forth over the face of the whole earth: for every one that steals shall be **cleansed (removed)** *as* on this side according to it; and every one that swears shall be **cleansed (removed)** *as* on that side according to it.

# H5355 - innocent - [Undefiled]

Gen. 24:41 Then shall you be **innocent** from *this* my oath, when you come to my kindred; and if they give you not *one*, you shalt be **innocent** from my oath.

Gen. 44:10 And he said, Now also *let* it *be* according to your words: he with whom it is found shall be my servant; and you shall be **innocent**.

Ex. 21:28 If an ox gore a man or a woman so that they die: then the ox shall be surely stoned, and his flesh shall not be eaten; but the owner of the ox *shall be* **innocent**.

Ex. 23:7 Keep far from a false matter; and the **innocent** and just do not slay: for I will not justify the wicked.

Num. 32:22 And the land be subdued before YAHWEH: then afterward you shall return, and be **innocent** before YAHWEH, and before Israel; and this land shall be your possession before YAHWEH.

Deut. 19:10 That **innocent** blood be not shed in your land, which YAHWEH, your Elohim gives you *for* an inheritance, and *so* blood be upon you.

Deut. 19:13 Your eye shall not pity him, but you shalt put away *the guilt of* **innocent** blood from Israel, that it may go well with you.

Deut. 21:8 Be merciful, O YAHWEH, to Your people Israel, whom You have redeemed, and lay not **innocent** blood unto Your people Israel's charge. And the blood shall be forgiven them.

Deut. 21:9 So shal you put away the *guilt of* **innocent** blood from among you, when you shall do *that which is* right in the sight of YAHWEH.

Deut. 24:5 When a man has taken a new wife, he shall not go out to war, neither shall he be charged with any business: *but* he shall be **innocent** at home one year, and shall cheer up his wife which he has taken.

Deut. 27:25 Cursed *is* he that takes a reward to slay an **innocent** person. And all the people shall say, Amen.

Josh. 2:17 And the men said unto her, We *will be* **innocent** of this your oath which you have made us swear.

Josh. 2:19 And it shall be, *that* whoever shall go out of the doors of your house into the street, his blood *shall be* upon his head, and we *will be* **innocent**: and whoever shall be with you in the house, his blood *shall be* on our head, if *any* hand be upon him. Josh. 2:20 And if you utter this our business, then we will be **innocent** of your oath which you have made us to swear.

1Sam. 19:5 For he put his life in his hand, and slew the Philistine, and YAHWEH wrought a great salvation for all Israel: you saw *it*, and rejoiced: why then will you sin against **innocent** blood, to slay David without a cause?

2Sam. 3:28 And afterward when David heard *it*, he said, I and my kingdom *are* **innocent** before YAHWEH for ever from the blood of Abner the son of Ner:

2Sam. 14:9 And the woman of Tekoah said unto the king, My lord, O king, the iniquity be on me, and on my father's house: and the king and his throne be **innocent**.

1Kings 15:22 Then king Asa made a proclamation throughout all Judah; none *was* **innocent**: and they took away the stones of Ramah, and the timber thereof, with which Baasha had built; and king Asa built with them Geba of Benjamin, and Mizpah.

2Kings 21:16 Moreover Manasseh shed **innocent** blood very much, till he had filled Jerusalem from one end to another; beside his sin with which he made Judah to sin, in doing *that which was* evil in the sight of YAHWEH.

2Kings 24:4 And also for the **innocent** blood that he shed: for he filled Jerusalem with **innocent** blood; which YAHWEH would not pardon.

Job 4:7 Remember, I beg you, who *ever* perished, being **innocent**? or where were the just cut off?

Job 9:23 If the scourge slays suddenly, he will laugh at the trial of the innocent.

Job 17:8 Upright *men* shall be astonished at this, and the **innocent** shall stir up himself against the hypocrite.

Job 22:19 The just see *it*, and are glad: and the **innocent** laugh them to scorn.

Job 22:30 He shall not deliver the **innocent**: and it is delivered by the **purity (1252)** of your hands.

Job 27:17 He may prepare *it*, but the just shall put *it* on, and the **innocent** shall divide the silver.

Psa. 10:8 He sits in the lurking places of the villages: in the secret places does he murder the **innocent**: his eyes are covered against the poor.

Psa. 15:5 *He that* puts not out his money to usury, nor takes reward against the **innocent**. He that does these *things* shall never be moved.

Psa. 24:4 He that hath **innocent** hands, and a **pure (1249)** heart; who has not lifted up his being to vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.

Psa. 94:21 They gather themselves together against the being of the just, and condemn the **innocent** blood.

Psa. 106:38 And shed **innocent** blood, *even* the blood of their sons and of their daughters, whom they sacrificed to the idols of Canaan: and the land was polluted with blood.

Prov. 1:11 If they say, Come with us, let us lay wait for blood, let us lurk in hiding for the **innocent** without cause:

Prov. 6:17 A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood,

Is. 59:7 Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed **innocent** blood: their thoughts *are* thoughts of iniquity; wasting and destruction *are* in their paths.

Jer. 2:34 Also in your skirts is found the blood of the beings of the poor **innocents**: I have not found it by secret search, but upon all these.

Jer. 7:6 *If* you oppress not the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, and shed not **innocent** blood in this place, nor walk after other gods to your hurt:

Jer. 19:4 Because they have forsaken Me, and have estranged this place, and have burned incense in it unto other gods, whom neither they nor their fathers have known, nor the kings of Judah, and have filled this place with the blood of **innocents**;

Jer. 22:3 Thus says YAHWEH; Execute judgment and justice, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor: and do no wrong, do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed **innocent** blood in this place.

Jer. 22:17 But your eyes and your heart *are* not but for your covetousness, and for shedding **innocent** blood, and for oppression, and for violence, to do *it*.

Jer. 26:15 But know for certain, that if you put me to death, you shall surely bring **innocent** blood upon yourselves, and upon this city, and upon the inhabitants thereof: for of a truth YAHWEH has sent me to you to speak all these words in your ears.

Joel 3:19 Egypt shall be a desolation, and Edom shall be a desolate wilderness, for the violence *against* the children of Judah, because they have shed **innocent** blood in their land.

Jonah 1:14 Therefore they cried unto YAHWEH, and said, We beseech You, O YAHWEH, we beseech You, let us not perish for this man's life, and lay not upon us **innocent** blood: for You, O YAHWEH, have done as it pleased You.

# H5356 - clearness, innocence - [Undefiled]

Gen. 20:5 Said he not to me, She *is* my sister? and she, even she herself said, He *is* my brother: in the integrity of my heart and **innocency** of my hands have I done this.

Psa. 26:6 I will wash mine hands in **innocency**: so will I go abour Your altar, O YAHWEH:

Psa. 73:13 Truly I have cleansed my heart *in* vain, and washed my hands in **innocency**.

Hos. 8:5 Your calf, O Samaria, has cast *you* off; My anger is kindled against them: how long *will it be* before they attain to **innocency**?

Amos 4:6 And I also have given you **clearness** of teeth in all your cities, and lack of bread in all your places: yet you have not returned unto me, says YAHWEH.

### H5462 - to shut up; enclose; surrender - [Undefiled]

This term occurs 91 times in Scripture. There is a unique usage of this that refers to a type of gold. The reference is to some type of purity, but the reference is not well understood. No references are provided due to this unique usage.

#### H5708 - to set a period; menstruation - [Defiled]

Is. 64:6 But we are all as a **defiled (2931)** *thing*, and all our right acts *are* as **menstrual** rags; and we all wither like a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

#### H6172 - nakedness; disgrace - [Defilement]

Deut. 23:14 For YAHWEH, your Elohim, walks in the midst of your camp, to deliver you, and to give up your enemies before you; therefore shall your camp be holy: that He see no **disgraceful thing** among you, and turn away from you.

Deut. 24:1 When a man has taken a wife, and married her, and it come to pass that she finds no favor in his eyes, because he has found some **disgracefulness** in her: then let him write her a bill of divorcement, and give *it* in her hand, and send her out of his house.

#### H6338 - to refine; finest - [Undefiled]

1Kings 10:18 Moreover the king made a great throne of ivory, and overlaid it with the **most refined (purest)** gold.

**H6663 - to be or make right (has the sense of cleanse) - [Undefiled]** Only twice is it used in the sense of cleansing.

Both of these are mis-translations.

Gen. 44:16 And Judah said, What shall we say to my sovereign? what shall we speak? or how shall we **clear** ourselves? The Elohim has found out the iniquity of your servants: behold, we *are* my sovereign's servants, both we, and *he* also with whom the cup is found.

Dan. 8:14 And he said unto me, Unto two thousand and three hundred days; then shall the sanctuary be **cleansed**.

#### H6674 - soiled, as if excrementitious; filthy - [Defiled]

Zech. 3:3 Now Joshua was clothed with filthy garments, and stood before the angel.

Zech. 3:4 And he answered and spoke to those that stood before him, saying, Take away the **filthy** garments from him. And to him he said, Behold, I have caused your iniquity to pass from you, and I will clothe you with a change of raiment.

### H6675 - excrement; filth - [Defiled]

Prov. 30:12 *There is* a generation *that are* pure in their own eyes, and *yet* is not washed from their **filthiness**.

Is. 4:4 When the Lord shall have washed away the **filth** of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning.

Is. 28:8 For all tables are full of vomit and filthiness, so that there is no place clean.

#### H6884 - refine; purify with fire - [Undefiled]

Judg. 7:4 And YAHWEH said to Gideon, The people *are* yet *too* many; bring them down unto the water, and I will **refine** them for you there: and it shall be, *that* of whom I say to you, This shall go with you, the same shall go with you; and of whomever I say to you, This shall not go with you, the same shall not go.

#### H6942 - to be or make clean; consecrate - [Undefiled]

This term occurs 172 times.

It typically is translated as "sanctify".

Sanctification, or consecration, is a form of purifying, of making undefiled.

As such all 172 occurrences could be properly translated as "undefile" (and its variants). Also, sanctifiying has to do with making "holy", setting one apart for a special purpose typically to serve YAHWEH.

To be "holy" (set apart for YAHWEH's service) one **must be 'clean', "pure" - undefiled!** Due to the number of occurrences the references are not listed here.

#### H8251 - disgusting, filthy; detestable - [Defiled]

Deut. 29:17 And you have seen their **disgusting things**, and their idols, wood and stone, silver and gold, which *were* among them:)

1Kings 11:5 For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, and after Milcom the **disgusting thing** of the Ammonites.

1Kings 11:7 Then Solomon built high place for Chemosh, the **disgusting thing** of Moab, in the hill that *is* before Jerusalem, and for Molech, the **disgusting thing** of the children of Ammon.

2Kings 23:13 And the high places that *were* before Jerusalem, which *were* on the right hand of the mount of corruption, which Solomon the king of Israel had built for Ashtoreth the **disgusting thing** of the Zidonians, and for Chemosh the **disgusting thing** of the

Moabites, and for Milcom the abomination of the children of Ammon, did the king **defile** (2930).

2Kings 23:24 Moreover the *workers with* familiar vital essences, and the wizards, and the images, and the idols, and all the **disgusting things** that were spied in the land of Judah and in Jerusalem, did Josiah put away, that he might perform the words of the law which were written in the book that Hilkiah the priest found in the house of YAHWEH.

2Chr. 15:8 And when Asa heard these words, and the prophecy of Oded the prophet, he took courage, and put away the **disgusting things** out of all the land of Judah and Benjamin, and out of the cities which he had taken from mount Ephraim, and renewed the altar of YAHWEH, that *was* before the porch of YAHWEH.

Is. 66:3 He that kills an ox *is as if* he slew a man; he that sacrifices a lamb, *as if* he cut off a dog's neck; he that offers an oblation, *as if he offered* swine's blood; he that burns incense, *as if* he blessed an idol. Yes, they have chosen their own ways, and their being delights in their **disgusting things**.

Jer. 4:1 If you wilt return, O Israel, says YAHWEH, return to Me: and if you will put away your **disgusting things** out of My sight, then you shal not be removed.

Jer. 7:30 For the children of Judah have done evil in My sight, says YAHWEH: they have set their **disgusting things** in the house which is called by My name, to pollute it.

Jer. 13:27 I have seen your adulteries, and your neighings, the lewdness of your whoredom, *and* your **disgusting things** on the hills in the fields. Woe to you, O Jerusalem! Will you not be **purified (2891)**? When *shall it* once *happen*?

Now you can understand the confusion caused by the use of multiple terms. Many of these could be replaced quite readily with a few simple terms. This would reduce the confusion and provide consistency of understanding. There are different types of "cleansing", but it really comes down to two simple concepts. The physical cleansing and the non-physical cleansing.

Either you are **undefiled**, or you are **defiled**. That's real issue in the teachings of Scripture. If you can grasp that concept and keep it before you it will greatly reduce your confusion.

# The New Covenant

The New Covenant terms are all in Greek. There are some corresponding Hebrew terms, but not for every Greek term. Wherever there is no Greek equivalent for a Hebrew term there will be confusion. Some of the equivalent terms are noted. However, a careful search to discover all equivalents has not been made.

Ideally, we could match every word to its Hebrew counterpart. This would improve the accuracy and the consistency of Scripture. It would also eliminate much confusion.

Matt. 12:43 When the **defiled vital essence** has gone out of a man, he walks through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none.

Mark 1:26 And when the **defiled vital essence** had torn him, and cried with a loud voice, he came out of him.

Mark 1:27 And they were all amazed, insomuch that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is this? what new doctrine *is* this? for with authority He commands even the **defiled vital essences**, and they obey him.

And the **defiled vital essences** went out, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, (they were about two thousand;) and were choked in the sea.

Mark 6:7 And he called *unto Him* the twelve, and began to send them forth by two and two; and gave them power over **defiled vital essences**;

Mark 7:25 For a *certain* woman, whose young daughter had a **defiled vital essence** heard of Him, and came and fell at His feet:

Mark 9:25 When YAHUSHUA saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the **defiled vital essence**, saying unto him, *You* dumb and deaf vital essence, I charge you, come out of him, and enter no more into him.

Luke 4:33 And in the synagogue there was a man, who had a **defiled vital essence of a demon**, and cried out with a loud voice,

Luke 4:36 And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word *is* this! for with authority and power he commandeth the **defiled vital essences**, and they come out.

Luke 6:18 And they that were harassed by **defiled vital essences**: and they were healed.

Luke 8:29 (For he had commanded the **defiled vital essence** to come out of the man. For often it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he broke the bands, and was driven by the devil into the wilderness.)

Luke 9:42 And as He was still coming, the demon threw him down, and tore *him*. And YAHUSHUA rebuked the **defiled vital essence**, and healed the child, and delivered him again to his father.

Luke 11:24 When the **defiled vital essence** has gone out of a man, he walks through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he says, I will return unto my house from where I came out.

Acts 5:16 There came also a multitude *out* of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were harassed by **defiled vital essences**: and they were healed every one.

Acts 8:7 For **defiled vital essences**, crying with a loud voice, came out of many that were possessed *with them*: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.

Acts 10:14 But Peter said, Not so, Master; for I have never eaten any thing that is common or **defiled**.

Acts 10:28 And he said unto them, You know how that it is an unlawful thing for a man that is a Jew to keep company, or come unto one of another nation; but YAHWEH has shown me that I should not call any man common or **defiled**.

Acts 11:8 But I said, Not so, Master: for nothing common or **defiled** has at any time entered into my mouth.

1Cor. 7:14 For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband: otherwise your children are **defiled**; but now are they set apart.

2Cor. 6:17 Therefore come out from among them, and be separate, says YAHWEH, and touch not the **defiled** *thing*; and I will receive you,

Eph. 5:5 For this you know, that no whoremonger, nor **defiled** person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, has any inheritance in the kingdom of The Messiah and of YAHWEH.

Rev. 16:13 And I saw three **defiled vital essences** like frogs *come* out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

Rev. 18:2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and has become the habitation of demons, and the hold of every **defiled vital essence**, and a cage of every **defiled** and hateful bird.

#### G766 - morally unrestrained; filthy - [Defiled]

Mark 7:22 Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, **lack of moral restraint**, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness:

Rom. 13:13 Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and **lack of moral restraint**, not in strife and envying.

2Cor. 12:21 *And* lest, when I come again, my Elohim will humble me among you, and *that* I shall bewail many which have sinned already, and have not repented of the uncleanness and fornication and **lack of moral restraint** which they have committed.

Gal. 5:19 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are *these*; Adultery, fornication, **defilement (167)**, **lack of moral restraint**,

Eph. 4:19 Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto a **lack of moral restraint**, to work all **defilement (167)** with greediness.

1Pet. 4:3 For the time past of *our* life may suffice us to have wrought the will of the Gentiles, when we walked in **lack of moral restraint**, lusts, excess of wine, revellings, banquetings, and abominable idolatries:

2Pet. 2:7 And delivered just Lot, harassed with the **lack of moral restraint** in the conversation of the wicked:

2Pet. 2:18 For when they speak great swelling *words* of vanity, they allure through the lusts of the flesh, *through much* **lack of moral restraint**, those that had indeed escaped from those who live in error.

Jude 4 For there certain men have crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the favor of our Elohim into a **lack of moral restraint**, and denying the only Sovereign, YAHWEH, and our Master, YAHUSHUA, The Messiah.

#### G1245 - to cleanse perfectly; purify - [Undefiled]

Matt. 3:12 Whose fan *is* in his hand, and He will **throughly cleanse** his floor, and gather His wheat into the garner; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

Luke 3:17 Whose fan *is* in his hand, and He will **throughly cleanse** his floor, and will gather the wheat into His garner; but the chaff He will burn with fire unquenchable.

{Note the exact duplication in the above two verses.}

#### G1506 - judged by sunlight; tested as genuine; pure - [Undefiled]

Phil. 1:10 That you may approve things that are excellent; that you may be **pure** and without offence until the day of The Messiah;

2Pet. 3:1 This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in *both* which I stir up your **pure** minds by way of remembrance:

#### G1571 - to cleanse thoroughly - [Undefiled]

1Cor. 5:7 **Cleanse thoroughly** therefore the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you are unleavened. For even The Messiah our Passover *Lamb* has been sacrificed for us:

2Tim. 2:21 If a man therefore **cleanse** himself **thoroughly** from these he shall be a vessel of honor, sanctified, and fitting for the Master's use, *and* prepared for every good work.

#### G 2511 - to cleanse; purify - [Undefiled]

**Note:** The concept matches the Hebrew concept of making one **undefiled**. The Greek actually encompasses several Hebrew terms that deal with this. Because of this we will use **"purify"** (and its variants).

Matt. 8:2 And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Master, if You desire, You can **purify** me.

Matt. 8:3 And YAHUSHUA put forth *His* hand, and touched him, saying, I desire; be **purified**. And immediately his leprosy was **purified**.

Matt. 10:8 Heal the sick, **purify** the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely you have received, freely give.

Matt. 11:5 The blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are **purified**, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them.

Matt. 23:25 Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for you **purify** the outside of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of extortion and excess. Matt. 23:26 *You* blind Pharisee, **purify** first that *which is* within the cup and platter, that the outside of them may be **pure (2513)** also.

Mark 1:40 And there came a leper to Him, beseeching Him, and kneeling down to Him, and saying unto Him, If You desire, You can make me **purified**.

Mark 1:41 And YAHUSHUA, moved with compassion, put forth *His* hand, and touched him, and said to him, I desire; be **purified**.

Mark 1:42 And as soon as He had spoken, immediately the leprosy departed from him, and he was **purified**.

Mark 7:19 Because it enters not into his heart, but into the belly, and goes out into the toilet, **purifying** all foods?

Luke 4:27 And many lepers were in Israel in the time of Elisha the prophet; and none of them was **purified** except Naaman, the Syrian.

Luke 5:12 And it came to pass, when He was in a certain city, behold a man full of leprosy: who seeing YAHUSHUA fell on *his* face, and besought Him, saying, Master, if You desire You can **purify** me.

Luke 5:13 And He put forth *His* hand, and touched him, saying, I desire. Be **purified**. And immediately the leprosy departed from him.

Luke 7:22 Then YAHUSHUA answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell John what things you have seen and heard; how the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are **purified**, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the good news is proclaimed.

Luke 11:39 And the Master said to him, Now you Pharisees **purify** the outside of the cup and the platter; but your inward part is full of ravening and wickedness.

Luke 17:14 And when He saw *them*, he said unto them, Go show yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were **purified**.

Luke 17:17 And YAHUSHUA answering said, Were there not ten **purified**? But where *are* the nine?

Acts 10:15 And the voice *spoke* unto him again the second time, What YAHWEH has **purified**, do not call profane.

Acts 11:9 But the voice answered me again from The Heaven, What YAHWEH has **purified** do not call profane.

Acts 15:9 And put no difference between us and them, **purifying** their hearts by faith.

2Cor. 7:1 Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us **purify** ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and vita; lessencet, perfecting holiness in the fear of YAHWEH.

Eph. 5:26 That He might sanctify and **purify** it with the washing of water by the word,

Titus 2:14 Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, and **purify** unto Himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

Heb. 9:14 How much more shall the blood of The Messiah, who through the eternal vital essence offered Himself without spot to YAHWEH, **purify** your conscience from dead works to serve the living Elohim?

Heb. 9:22 And almost all things are by the law **purified** with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

Heb. 9:23 *It was* therefore necessary that the patterns of things in The Heavens should be **purified** with these; but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.

James 4:8 Draw nigh to YAHWEH, and He will draw nigh to you. **purify** *your* hands, *you* sinners; and **cleanse (48)** *your* hearts, *you* double minded.

1John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of YAHUSHUS, The Messiah, his Son, **purifies** us from all sin.

1John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to **purify** us from all unrighteousness.

#### G 2512 - a washing off; purification - [Undefiled]

Mark 1:44 And said to him, See you say nothing to any man: but go your way, show yourself to the priest, and offer for your **purification** those things which Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.

Luke 2:22 And when the days of her **purification** according to the law of Moses were accomplished, they brought him to Jerusalem, to present *him* to YAHWEH;

Luke 5:14 And he charged him to tell no man: but go, and show yourself to the priest, and offer for **purification**, according as Moses commanded, for a testimony to them.

John 2:6 And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the **purification** of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece.

John 3:25 Then there arose a question between *some* of John's disciples and the Jews about **purification**.

Heb. 1:3 Who being the brightness of H*is* glory, and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when He had by Himself **purified** our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

2Pet. 1:9 But he that lacks these things is blind, and cannot see far off, and hsth forgotten that he was **purified** from his old sins.

#### G2513 - clean; pure - [Undefiled]

Matt. 5:8 Blessed are the **pure** in heart: for they shall see YAHWEH.

Matt. 23:26 Blind Pharisee, **purify (2511)** first that *which is* within the cup and platter, that the outside of them may be **pure** also.

Matt. 27:59 And when Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a pure linen cloth,

Luke 11:41 But rather give cpompassionate deeds of such things as you have; and, behold, all things are **pure** unto you.

John 13:10 YAHUSHUA said to him, He that is washed needs notthing except to wash *his* feet, and is **pure** all over: and you are **pure**, but not all of you. John 13:11 For He knew who should betray Him; therefore said He, You are not all **pure**.

John 15:3 Now you are **pure** through the word which I have spoken to you.

Acts 18:6 And when they opposed themselves, and blasphemed, he shook *his* raiment, and said unto them, Your blood *be* upon your own heads; I *am* **pure**: from now on I will go to the Gentiles.

Acts 20:26 Wherefore I take you to record this day, that I *am* **pure** from the blood of all *men*.

Rom. 14:20 For food do not destroy the work of YAHWEH. All things indeed *are* **pure**; but *it is* hurtful for that man who eats with offence.

1Tim. 1:5 Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a **pure** heart, and *of* a good conscience, and *of* sincere faith:

1Tim. 3:9 Holding the mystery of the faith in a **pure** conscience.

2Tim. 1:3 I thank YAHWEH, whom I serve from *my* forefathers with a **pure** conscience, that without ceasing I have remembrance of you in my prayers night and day;

2Tim. 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow justice, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Master out of a **pure** heart.

Titus 1:15 Unto the **pure** all things *are* **pure**: but unto those who are **defiled (3392)** and unbelieving *is* nothing **pure**; but even their mind and conscience is **defiled(3392)**.

Heb. 10:22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from a hurtfulconscience, and our bodies washed with **pure** water.

James 1:27 **Pure** religion and undefiled before YAHWEH, even The Father, is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, *and* to keep himself unspotted from the world.

1Pet. 1:22 Seeing you have **purified (48)** your beings in obeying the truth through the vital essence for the sake of sincere love of the brethren, *see that you* love one another with a **pure** heart fervently:

\Rev. 15:6 And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in **pure** and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles.

Rev. 19:8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, **pure** and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

Rev. 19:14 And the armies *which were* in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and **pure**.

Rev. 21:18 And the building of the wall of it was *of* jasper: and the city *was* **pure** gold, like unto **pure** glass.

Rev. 21:21 And the twelve gates *were* twelve pearls; every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city *was* **pure** gold, as it were transparent glass.

Rev. 22:1 And he showed me a **pure** river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of YAHWEH and of the Lamb.

#### G2514 - cleanness; purification - [Undefiled]

Heb. 9:13 For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the **defiled (2840)**, sanctifies for the sake of **purification** of the flesh:

#### G2839 - common (lit. - shared by all); profane - [Defiled]

Mark 7:2 And when they saw some of His disciples eat bread with **defiled**, that is to say, with unwashed, hands, they found fault.

Acts 10:14 But Peter said, Not so, Lord; for I have never eaten any thing that is **defiled** or **impure (169)**.

Acts 10:28 And he said unto them, You know how that it is an unlawful thing for a man that is a Jew to keep company, or come unto one of another nation; but YAHWEH has showed me that I should not call any man **defiled** or **impure (169)**.

Acts 11:8 But I said, Not so, Mastere: for nothing **defiled** or **impure (169)** has at any time entered into my mouth.

Rom. 14:14 I know, and am persuaded by the Master YAHUSHUA, that *there is* nothing **defiled** of itself: but to him that esteems any thing to be **defiled**, to him *it is* **defiled**.

Heb. 10:29 Of how much sorer punishment do you suppose shall he be thought worthy, who has trodden under foot the Son of God, and has counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, a **defiled** thing, and has insulted unto the vital essence of favorableness?

#### G2840 - to make profane; defile - [Defiled]

Matt. 15:11 Not that which goes into the mouth **defiles** a man; but that which comes out of the mouth, this **defiles** a man.

Matt. 15:18 But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart; and they **defile** the man.

Matt. 15:20 These are *the things* which **defile** a man: but to eat with unwashen hands does not **defile** a man.

Mark 7:15 There is nothing from outside a man, that entering into him can **defile** him: but the things which come out of him, those are they that **defile** the man.

Mark 7:18 And He said to them, Are ye so without understanding also? Do you not perceive, that whatever thing from outside enters into the man, *it* cannot **defile** him;

Mark 7:20 And He said, That which comes out of the man, that defiles the man.

Mark 7:23 All these hurtful things come from within, and **defile** the man.

Acts 10:15 And the voice *spoke* to him again the second time, What YAHWEH has **purified (2511)**, do not call **defiled**.

Acts 11:9 But the voice answered me again from The Heaven, What YAHWEH has **purified (2511)**, do not call **defiled**.

Acts 21:28 Crying out, Men of Israel, help: This is the man, that teaches all *men* every where against the people, and the law, and this place: and further brought Greeks also into the temple, and has **defiled** this holy place.

Heb. 9:13 For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the **defiled**, sanctifies to the **purification (2514)** of the flesh:

Rev. 21:27 And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that **defiles**, neither *whatever* makes destestable, or *makes* a lie: but they who are written in the Lamb's book of life.

# G3392 - defile - [Defiled]

John 18:28 Then led they YAHUSHUA from Caiaphas to the hall of judgment: and it was early; and they themselves went not into the judgment hall, lest they should be **defiled**; so that they might eat The Passover.

Titus 1:15 To the **pure (2513)** all things *are* **pure (2513)**: but to those that are **defiled** and unbelieving *is* nothing **pure (2513)**; but even their mind and conscience is **defiled**.

Heb. 12:15 Looking diligently lest any man lack the kindness of YAHWEH; lest any root of bitterness springing up troubles *you*, and thereby many are **defiled**;

Jude 8 Likewise also these dreamers **defile** the flesh, despise dominion, and speak hurtful of dignities.

# G3393 - defilement - [Defiled]

2Pet. 2:20 For if after they have escaped the **defilements** of the world through the knowledge of the Master and Redeemer, YAHUSHUA, The Messiah, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.

# G3394 - contamination; defilement - [Defiled]

2Pet. 2:10 But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of **defillement**, and despise government. Presumptuous *are they*, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak hurtfully of dignities.

# G4027 - refuse; garbage - [Defiled]

1Cor. 4:13 Being defamed, we intreat: we are made as the **refuse** of the world, *and are* the offscouring (scum) of all things unto this day.

# G4507 - moral filthiness - [Defiled]

James 1:21 Wherefore lay apart all **moreal filthiness** and excess of depravity, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your beings.

# G4508 - dirty - [Defiled]

James 2:2 For if there comes unto your assembly a man with a gold ring, in nice apparel, and there comes in also a poor man in **dirty** clothing;

# G4509 - depravity; filth - [Defiled]

1Pet. 3:21 The same figure where *even* baptism also now saves us (not the putting away of the **depravity** of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward YAHWEH,) by the resurrection of YAHUSHUA, The Messiah:

# G4510 - to soil; filthy - [Defiled]

Rev. 22:11 He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is **filthy**, let him be **filthy** still: and he that is just, let him be justs still: and he that is set apart, let him be set apart still.

The last two terms, G4509 and G4510, are tied to the Hebrew concept of excrement, H6675. The level of filth so identified is significant. It is entirely missed in the Greek.
